Stratton Small, Tough Linebacker Gaining Reputation

On the A&M football squad middle linebacker Ken Stratton is building a reputation as a scrapper.

Not the kind who fights with his fists. But the type who gives a fiery performance everytime he goes into action.

Stratton, a junior from Houston Spring Branch knows what the situation is this week when the Aggies invade LSU. "You gotta realize that LSU is going to attack you and you have to be ready to attack them."

Stratton knows what it is to scrap and attack. He's had to

fight for his position since last spring when JC transfer John Paul McCrumby, 6-2 and 245, made his appearance as his challenger for the middle linebacker's post. Though only 5-10 and 190, Ken has successfully fought off big John's strong challenge.

"I guess I wish I were bigger," Stratton says, "But I've got to play with what I've got and not worry about being larger."

Stratton calls A&M's defensive signals and consequently he believes he has gained a broader understanding of the overall defense. "I just seem to get a clearer picture of what we're trying to do."

is coming along fast, too, and he'll get even better."

At Spring Branch, Stratton was the starting linebacker his last two years and played second-team fullback on offense. "I like the linebacker's position much better than playing offense, though."

Even though the Aggie defense was impressive in the 48-0 shut-out of Wichita State last week, Stratton sees room for a lot of improvement. "We haven't played together enough yet. We're still young in that aspect, but I think the defense has a lot of talent and we just need to play more games together. We've just got to keep getting better and better."

Last year Stratton was the back-up man to Grady Hoermann. He played in every game except Nebraska game. Right now, he's a two-for-two as a starter, since the Aggies beat Arkansas last year and Wichita State this year.
