Bean Nabs Player of the Week Honors

11th Best Rushing Day in SWC History

Bubba Bean continues to out-run his injuries just like he does enemy defensive backs.

The swift A&M halfback, who fought back a seige of injuries to make the Class 2A All-State team at Kirbyville High School, showed Saturday what happens

when the 19-year-old with John David Crow's old number is healthy.

No. 44 flashed for 204 yards on 22 carries, including a 76-yard touchdown run, in A&M's 30-15 victory over Clemson to earn the Aggie sophomore The Associated Press Southwest Conference Offensive Player of the Week

award.
"I think I see a parallel in my high school and collegiate careers," Bean said. "I was out as a high school freshman because of cracked ribs. The next year I missed two games with a calcium deposit. Then got better and better every game."

Bean injured an ankle in the Texas High School Coaches Association All-Star game in Houston after graduation and was hampered all last year. He was knocked into a bench this fall and suffered a thigh bruise which has finally healed.

Bean's performance Saturday was the 11th best rushing day on SWC books. It would have set a record except for a guy by the name of Bob Smith who rushed for 297 and 214 in Aggie games back in the 1950s.

"It kind of shocked me when I learned I had 200 yards," Bean said. "I really didn't think I had carried the ball over 17 times."

Bean wears the uniform number of the fabled All-American Crow out of necessity.
"That's the number I wore in high school and it's just about the only way my mother can recognize me on the football field," Bean said. "I don't want to be another Crow. I know it's a big symbol here, but I'd just like to establish Bubba Bean."

The Aggies brought No. 44 out of retirement during Gene Stallings' regime for Brad Dusek to wear. Dusek never reached Crow's status.

The 6-foot-1, 193-pound Bean

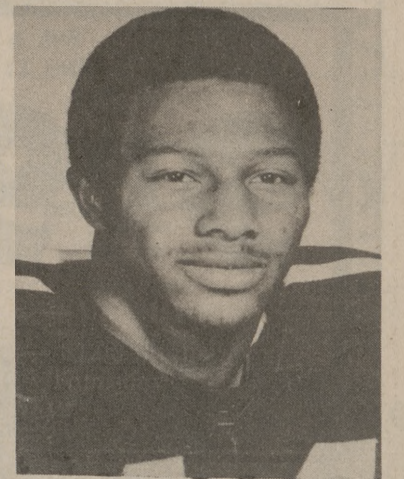
once ran a 9.6 in the 100-yard dash at Kirbyville but confessed "there may have been a little wind at my back."

Bean has proved a tough blocker in the run-oriented Aggie Wishbone-T.

"I get to block a lot, but I like football even when I'm not carrying the football," Bean said.

Asked if he thought the young A&M team had gotten over its quarterback problems and tendency to make mistakes, Bean said "Well, nobody's perfect, you know."

He added "Four games is all the experience any team should need to get ready for the conference. I know one thing — we've got a lot of confidence."

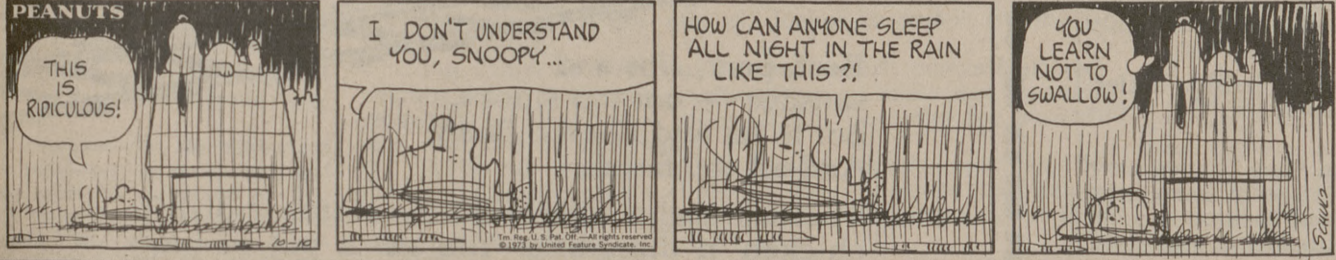
