

committee were the main problems in last year's proposal," said Dr. Tom Adair, assistant to the president.

"Last year's proposed budget was incomplete," said Gwen Flynt who is now working on the project. "There were no provisions for office renovation or a law

Flynt agrees, "Students would not know what questions to ask in selecting an attorney."

House Bill 83, passed this summer in the Texas legislature caused another complication with the attorney proposal.

The bill prorated student service fees. State universities hesitant to commit money before the effect of the bill on budgets could be determined.
