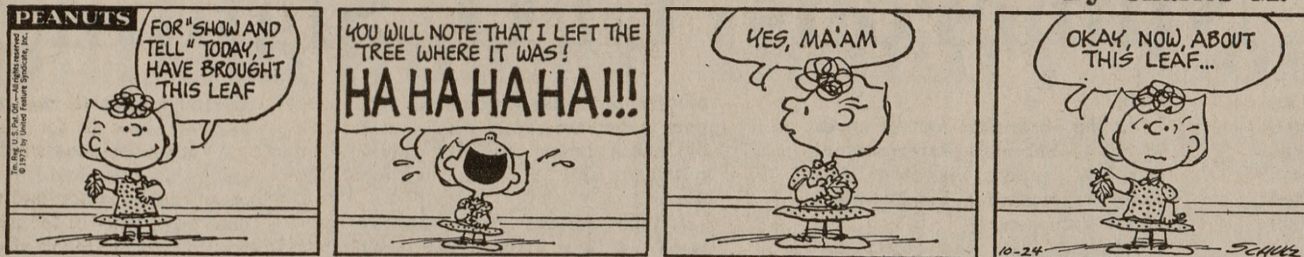

be on a voluntary basis and would incorporate on the steps the University is already taking to save energy.  
Senators will also discuss the need for an overall Recreational Facilities Development Program and the formation of a committee to recommend improvements and additions in various recreational

areas.  
These areas include outdoor facilities, basketball courts, football fields, softball fields, badminton courts, handball courts and volleyball courts.

The proposal states that recreational facilities have remained static since 1963 with no concern to the increase of student

population, particularly women. Demand has greatly exceeded the present capabilities of the facilities, according to the proposal.  
Senators will vote on whether or not to recommend the memorial status of the Memorial Student Center be officially extended to the grounds and new addition of the MSC.
