

HOUSTON - A state grand jury which returned 10 indictments in the Houston mass murders of 27 teen-aged boys ended its term Thursday with a blast at local law enforcement officials.

The grand jury issued a report critical of the police and district attorney's office, saying their investigation "lacked professional imagination, thoroughness and professional coordination."

The jurors said the Houston police abandoned the investigation about Sept. 1, leaving unexplored "the possible involvement of others and related criminal activities."

AUSTIN-The 37 citizen members of the Texas Constitutional Revision Commission who labored seven months to produce a proposed new state constitution placed it in the hands of the Texas Legislature Thursday.

"We do not suggest that this is a perfect constitution." said Robert W. Calvert, commission chairman and former chief justice of the Texas Supreme Court, at the climax of a historic ceremony in the Texas House.

MADISON, Wis. - Karleton L. Armstrong, who pleaded guilty to charges in the 1970 University of Wisconsin bombing that killed a physics researcher, was sentenced Thursday to 23 years in prison.

"Long live the revolution," the bearded Armstrong shouted after Circuit Court Judge William Sachtjen sentenced him on a second-degree murder charge.

The 27-year-old former University of Wisconsin student walked out of the courtroom with his right fist raised in salute. Supporters in the audience responded, "Right on, Karl."

Armstrong, who has been in custody since his arrest in Canada early last year, would be eligible for parole in five years. He still faces federal charges in connection with the bombing, in which physicist Robert Fassnacht, 33, was killed.

WASHINGTON - President Nixon nominated Ohio Republican Sen. William B. Saxbe as attorney general Thursday and promised full independence for a new special Watergate prosecutor. Texas trial lawyer Leon Jaworski.

Nixon gave his personal assurance that he would not fire the new special prosecutor as he did Archibald Cox without getting approval from congressional leaders of both parties.
