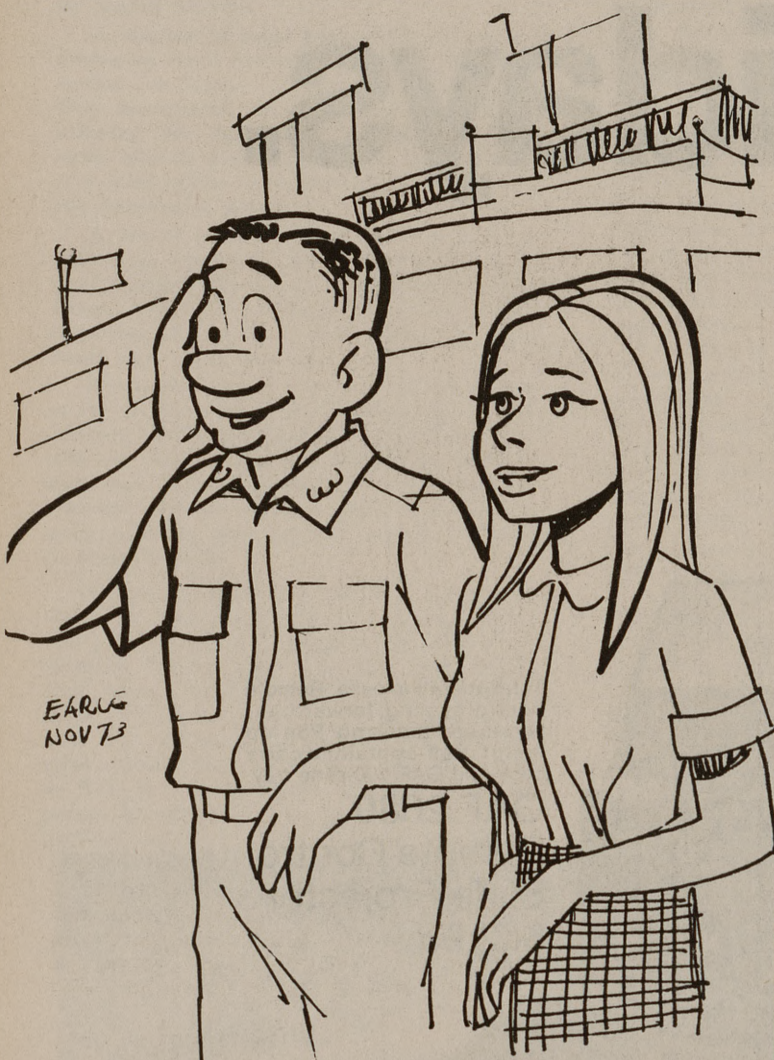

The five awards were given on a regional basis.

Brazos Aggies won the plaque in competition with clubs at Austin, Waco, Brownwood, Temple and Stephenville, among others in the Central Texas Region.

The local club was beaten out by Tyler for the statewide award.

Murder Charges

Charges have been filed in the shooting death of TAMU graduate James A. Hluchanek of Weimar in Colorado late last month.

TAMU officials recently learned of the events.

Charges of first-degree murder were filed last week in Weld County, Colo., against Jerry Ben Ulmer, 21, of Garland.

Hluchanek, 24, was on special geophysical work at Casper, Wyo., at the time of his death. Reports indicate no apparent motive for the shooting. Hluchanek was said to have been shot eight times. He was found dead in his car at a roadside park near the Colorado-Wyoming border 90 miles north of Denver on Oct. 31.

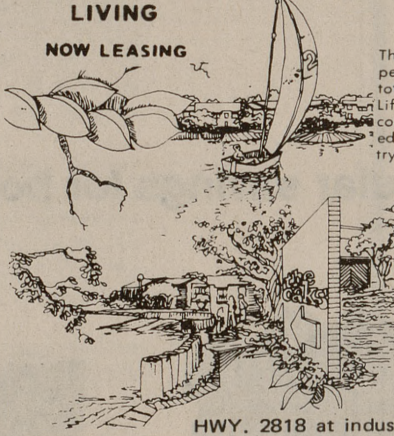

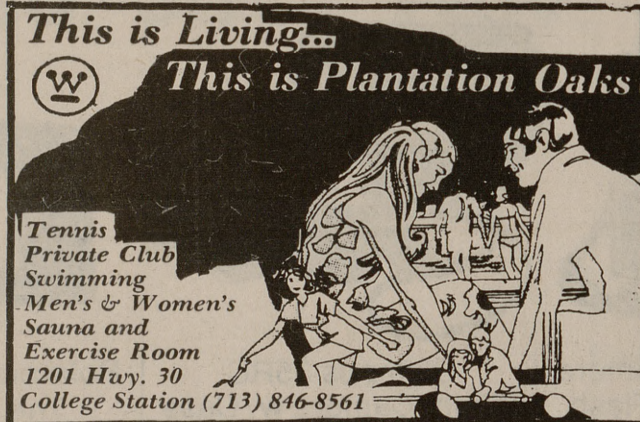
