Manager Hails Apartment Plans

Ken Nicolas, manager of the married student apartments has great plans for them. "I'd like to see the married students' apartments complex become the married student's community. A township of people acting like townfolk. A community living and doing things together," Nicolas said. "We need to get things going by getting the people together, doing things," Nicolas said. He hopes to have a Christmas activity near the office of the married students' apartments. Nicolas has started putting out weekly information bulletins for the convenience of apartment dwellers. "We're going to try to

put in a sort of calendar of community events to let the people know what's going on in the area," Nicolas said. Nicolas said the old College View apartments may be torn down beginning next summer. "We're going to vacate four of the old buildings," Nicolas said. He said they were built at two different Air Force bases in 1942, cut in half and transported here, where they were assembled. "They had a life expectancy of seven years and here we are in 1973, three decades later, still living in them. It's time they were taken out," he said. Ken Nicolas life at TAMU has been service. He served as Assistant to the Commandant of the Corps of Cadets for nine years and has been adviser to organizations such as SCONA (Student Conference on National Affairs). Nicolas does things in a quiet way. He doesn't believe in publicity. During the 12 years he has been here his picture has never appeared in the AggieLand. "My philosophy developed while I was in the service and while I worked with the Corps of Cadets and now as I work with the married students. If there wasn't a student then there wouldn't be any need for a teacher. If there were no cadets then there would be no need for an Assistant to the Commandant. It there were no married students then there would be no need for a married students' apartment manager. It's because of these people that I have a job, and my job is to serve these people the best I can."



Doctor's Door

Question: Are there any harmful effects from masturbation?
Answer: No. Any harmful effects observed are related not to the act itself but to the guilt which may be felt because of the practice.
Question: What is leukemia?
Answer: Leukemia is a disease characterized by an abnormally large number of a specific type of leukocyte (white blood cell) in the body, in the absence of a demonstrable cause. The leukemias are differentiated according to the type of white blood cell involved. Depending upon the type of leukemia and the efficacy of the therapy used, victims may die within a few days or live quite a long time, but with rare exceptions, all types of leukemia are eventually fatal.
Question: What is the incidence of mouth-area cancer among tobacco chew-

ers and snuff dippers? How does this compare with cigarettes?
Answer: The incidence of all mouth-area cancers is quite low compared with cancers in all other locations. The largest percentage of mouth-area cancers occurs in the lips and tongue—these prevail in tobacco chewers and snuff dippers. Cancer of the lip, especially the lower lip, is prevalent among cigarette smokers.
Question: What causes night-blindness?
Answer: Vitamin A deficiency. "Night-blindness" is the inability to see in subdued light (not total darkness). Vitamin A deficiencies are rare in the United States but endemic in the far and near East.

body can justify it." He said a teacher pay raise and the kindergarten program voted in 1969 pose increased prices in 1974. To meet the payroll alone, districts face having to cut the number of teachers and offer no pay raise incentive.
A new school financing bill in preparation will be similar to HB 946, Kubiak added. It will feature, among other things, the state paying a larger percentage of the cost, local control, fair market value of property, the possibility of combining districts in a county for assessing, collecting and distributing tax money and a \$700 base salary increase effective in 1976 "that would bring Texas teachers' salaries up to the national average."
The TAMU speaker said it would recommend one teacher per 15 kindergarten students, "where children learn the most and need the most help." It would suggest a 1-to-20 teacher-student ratio for grades one to three; 1-to-23 grades four to six and 1-to-24, grades seven to 12.
Increased funding in transportation and maintenance areas are also called for, Kubiak said.

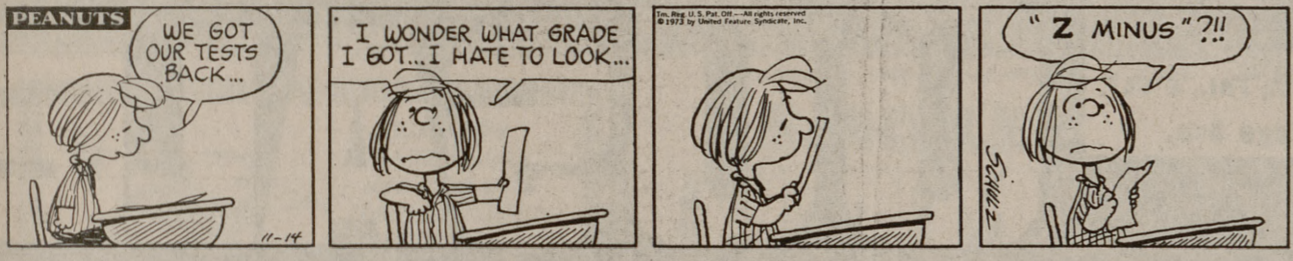
