Campus Briefs

Cottonseed Manual
Distribution of a Texas Engineering Experiment Station-prepared manual has begun to cottonseed mill operators.
The manual, prepared by a TEES-assembled multidisciplinary research team, will aid mill operators in bringing their facilities in line with air pollution regulations.
Subjects in the manual include methods of evaluating existing in-plant air conveying equipment, evaluating new air pollution control equipment, aids in air pollution control, and other areas of interest to oilseed mill operators.

Investments Course
The College of Business Administration will offer a basic course in investments this spring. The course, Finance 632: Investment Management, requires no prerequisites or previous knowledge of the area of finance.
The purpose of the three-hour course will be to expose the student to the basic fundamentals of investment management and develop the necessary skills for investment analysis and decision making.

Surge Control Program
Ten manufacturers and users of high-speed rotating machinery gathered Tuesday to discuss plans for a surge control program in the Mechanical Engineering Department.
The firms will provide approximately \$5,000 each toward a research and education program headed by Dr. M. P. Boyce, associate professor of mechanical engineering and head of the Gas Turbine Laboratory.

Physics Colloquiums
Physics colloquiums this week will feature a Russian physicist and a professor from the University of Washington.
Dr. B. P. Dotsenko of Wilfred Laurier University in Waterloo, Canada, will speak on "Physics in Russia" at 4 p.m. Wednesday in Room 146 of the Physics Building.

Architecture Presentation
Two leading figures in California architecture and health facilities planning will present slide-sound discussions at the College of Architecture Thursday and Friday.
Henrique and Mary Limosner, Berkeley, Calif., will meet with students and other interested persons in the Architecture Lab on the third floor of the Architecture Building at 2:30 p.m. Thursday, and in the Research Center behind the Architecture Building at the same time Friday.

Father of Geology
TAMU's Center for Tectonophysics recently hosted a renowned geologist, Prof. David T. Griggs from UCLA.
Griggs is widely regarded as the father of modern structural geology. He is with UCLA's Institute of Geophysics.
During a three-day November visit, Griggs spoke formally on "Evidence of Non-Newtonian Flow in the Mantle."

Police Study
The Center for Urban Programs will study police departments in selected Texas cities under a \$30,000 project sponsored by the Texas Criminal Justice Council.
The study, headed by Dr. Stephen Riter, associate professor of electrical engineering, will involve analysis of police department operations to determine benefits obtained from advanced communications and other law enforcement methods.

Oceanography Grant
The Oceanography Department has received a \$49,107 extension grant from the Office of Naval Research for continuing oceanographic studies in the Gulf of Mexico.
Dr. Richard A. Geyer, head of the department, said the funds will be used primarily for shake-down maneuvers on the department's new research vessel, the R/V Gyre.

Senior Seminar
Senior mechanical engineering students will hear Dr. M. J. (Bob) Fox, associate professor of industrial engineering, in Thursday's Mechanical Engineering Senior Seminar presentation.
Dr. Fox will discuss labor relations at 10 a.m. in Room 203 of the Zachry Engineering Center, according to seminar director James H. Caddess.

Aircraft Seminar
John Richardson, an engineering and sales representative with Mitsubishi Aircraft Corp., San Angelo, will discuss his firm's MU-2 aircraft Tuesday.
Richardson will speak to participants in the aerospace engineering senior seminar at 1 p.m. in Room 115 of the old Engineering Building, according to seminar director Dr. Charles A. Rodenberger.
