Supreme Court To Define 'Obscenity'

WASHINGTON (AP)-The Supreme Court may be ready to offer more definite guidelines to states and local officials on what is punishably obscene.

The court issued a routine order Monday agreeing to hear arguments in a case from Georgia involving a theater operator found guilty of violating state obscenity law for showing the critically praised movie "Carnal Knowledge."

The action comes only a few months after the court rewrote ing needs, North Gate. The action comes only a few obscenity law in a series of 5 to 4 decisions last term.

While those decisions strengthened the hand of prosecutors, Chief Justice Warren E. Burger said only material depicting "hard-core sexual conduct" should be subject to prosecution. Beyond the question of whether
