In the second case, police in Florida were permitted use as evidence marijuana discovered in a search that followed a routine warrantless traffic stop.

"A police officer's determination as to how and where to search the person of a suspect whom he has arrested is necessarily a quick . . . judgment which the Fourth Amendment does not require to be broken down in each instance into an analysis of each stey in the search." said Rehnquist.

Marshall, joined by Justices William J. Brennan, declared that 'the mere fact of an arrest should be no justification in and of itself for invading the privacy of the individual's personal effects.
