

Optional fees

People who get the most good from a service should pay the most for it, said John Nash.

Nash, a junior economics major and candidate for Vice President of External Affairs, stressed that he had done extensive work with the external affairs committee this year and had attended many conferences.

OPTIONAL FEES. A totally optional fee would be the ultimate goal, said Nash, but the administration, and perhaps the students, are not ready for that step. He does favor a user fee in the meantime.

PROFESSOR EVALUATIONS. Nash said that he would like to see the professor evaluations published for student use. If the administration does not do it, then the Student Government could.

LIQUOR ON-CAMPUS. "I am definitely in favor of liquor on campus and I think that Steve Eberhard expressed it very well," said Nash.

SG SALARIES. Student Government executive officers are not in school to obtain semi-professional training and should not be paid for their work.

PUNISHMENT. "I think that it is very healthy to have the kind of input we have seen from the Senate on disciplinary matter," said Nash. He said that it would be necessary to constantly review measures for offenses as

ACADEMIC COUNCIL. Nash said that he feels there is a need for as much student input as possible on all university committees.

NSL-TSL-TSA. As external affairs chairman, Nash said that it would be his goal to make TSL more responsive to the student bodies of the campuses represented. He said that a student referendum like that of the NSL would help the organization to better gauge what issues should win their support.
