specific crop. The other is to tell the yield per acre of that crop. The two together tell you the crop produc-

"The yield will be computed two ways," Harlan added. "Meteorological data will provide soil temperatures, air temperatures, humidity, precipitation and solar radiation that are indicators of growing conditions. This will be correlated with the updated remote satellite information for a more accurate current picture of crop situations.
