WASHINGTON (AP)—John W. Dean III, the principal accuser of former President Richard M. Nixon in the Watergate cover-up, surrendered today to begin serving a one-tofour-year prison term.

Dean turned himself in at 2:50 p.m. EDT at the U.S. District Courthouse. He is expected to Last Picture Show" and "Five be detained for some time at Ft. Holabird, Md., allowing him easy access to the Watergate cover-up trial scheduled to begin in Washington Sept. 30.

Dean had no comment when reporters asked if he felt Nixon also should face prosecution in the cover-up case.

The 35-year-old former White House counsel surrendered at the U.S. Marshal's office, where he was to be fingerprinted and undergo initial processing of his prison sentence.
