Study on pollutants underway

Studies on chemical wastes in the Gulf of Mexico are being conducted two researchers at TAMU.

Dr. Roy W. Hann, Jr. and Dr. ack Anderson are checking the ub-lethal effects of three common astes now being discharged into the Gulf.

Anderson is studying 25,000 amercial shrimp to determine he effects of the wastes on their rate f growth in different concentraons of the three types of wastes.

"The reason we check the growth ate is that everything has to be actioning correctly for growth to occur normally," Anderson said. If he growth rate is affected further study will be conducted to deternine why.

According to Hann, the study will etermine whether the safe levels ublished in the government's Ocean Dumping Regulations are
