Panel studies needs

Subcommittees were appointed by the University Traffic Panel to study the needs and possible improvements in campus regulations and facilities.

Chairman V. G. Stover announced at the panel meeting Wednesday that W. H. Thames will chair a subcommittee on University Motor Vehicle Regulations.

Current regulations will be reviewed and revisions will be drafted by mid-January, 1975. The policy concerning the issuing of duplicate parking permits is one of the areas to be considered for revision.

The subcommittee was asked to study parking needs for the handicapped, the need for and utilization of short-term and visitor parking facilities.

Metered parking was proposed

for short-term parking, but R. L. Melcher from the Office of the Vice President for Student Services reported that meters are often utilized by persons who should not be using them. An alternate proposal of hourly rates in specified parking areas was put forth.

A subcommittee chaired by Chris Lawson will study the inadequacies of motorcycle parking facilities.

D. L. Woods of the Texas Transportation Institute moved that the area adjacent to the hydro-mechanics lab be opened to motorcycle parking. After some discussion and arguments about high noise levels and the possibilities of problems caused by a sidewalk between the area and the street, the motion passed unanimously.

University Police Chief O. L. Luther proposed entrance to the area via parking lot 57. A ramp over

the curb at this point for easy access will be studied further by the motorcycle subcommittee.

Persons working in the vicinity of the Zachry Engineering Center have complained about noise reportedly caused by motorcycles in the area. Luther pointed out that University regulations stipulate a 75-decibel limit on noise emitted by any motor vehicle operated on campus. Stover suggested that the police obtain a meter from the industrial engineering department to be used for monitoring the noise in the area and to detect vehicles exceeding the prescribed limit.

Increases in the number of bicycles on campus prompted the panel to appoint a subcommittee to study the need for additional bicycle facilities and review current regulations.

Mary Ellen Martin was named chairwoman of the subcommittee.

Conflicts between bicycles and pedestrian traffic were cited as being particularly acute near the library. Stover asked the subcommittee to review the regulations concerning operation of bicycles in the mall areas and on the sidewalks.

German youth set model for amnesty

BONN, Germany (AP) — West German conscientious objectors care for the ill and handicapped, work in ambulances and rescue services and protect the environment in a project that could serve as a model for President Ford's amnesty program.

"Most West Germans believe that as long as there is a draft, there must be equality of service for all young men," said Manfred Harter of the West German Labor Ministry, which administers the conscientious objector program in-

itiated 18 years ago. "America may have something to learn from our experiences."

Ford has offered amnesty to draft evaders and deserters from the Vietnam war era in return for an oath of allegiance to the United States and for working up to two years in public services such as national health or safety.

About 30,000 West German youths will avoid the draft this year by establishing their status as conscientious objectors. To substitute for military service, they will be assigned by the Bonn government to 16 months of civilian service duties, compared with 15 months served by military recruits.

Their starting pay is about \$2 a day plus meals. Many will have to finance their own living quarters. Otherwise, they receive the same welfare benefits as army recruits.

Like the Ford proposal, the West German civilian service program has provoked controversy. There is grumbling from conscientious objectors about low pay and being forced to serve one month longer than soldiers in menial, make-work assignments.

There was a dramatic upsurge of COs in West Germany during the late 1960s, attributed partly to the American war in Vietnam.

Nomination postponed till election

WASHINGTON (AP) — Senate action on Nelson A. Rockefeller's nomination to be vice president was postponed Wednesday until after the Nov. 5 elections.

Chairman Howard W. Cannon, D-Nev., announced the delay, saying it would be impossible for the Senate Rules Committee to submit its recommendation on the nomination until Congress meets in a post-election session.

He told the Senate the postponement stems from the inability of the Joint Committee on Internal Revenue Taxation to report on Rockefeller's tax returns and other financial records cannot be completed before Oct. 18.

The Senate is scheduled to recess for the elections on Oct. 11. Senate Republican Whip Robert P. Griffin said Cannon's announcement was very disappointing. He said "many Americans think we should have a Vice President in office."

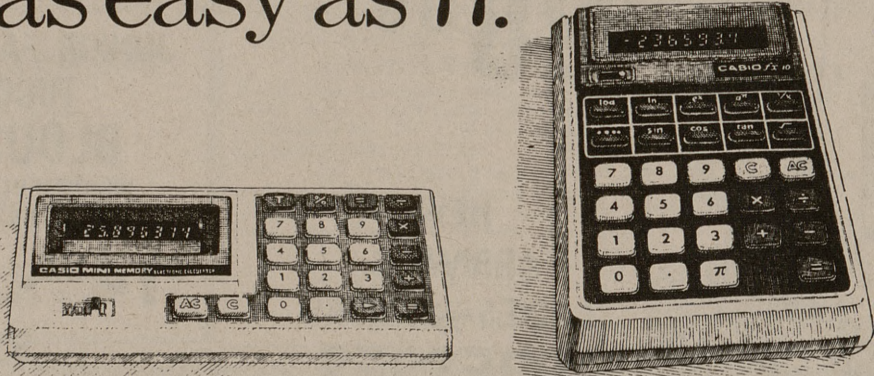
ROTC Rangers meet Mondays fitness, training

The Company is commanded by Topper Rush.

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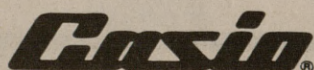
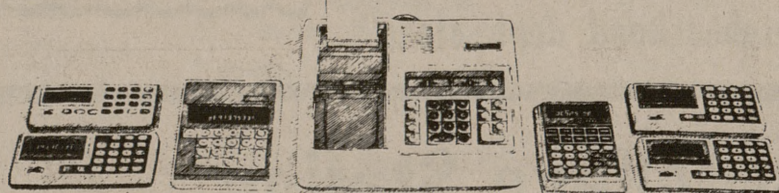
