Texas A&M received a Sea Grant of \$1,353,250 for marine-related research, education, and advisory services, said Rep. Olin E. (Tiger) Teague announced Tuesday in

Mideast settlement The grant from the U.S. Department of Commerce's National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) is for partial support of A&M's 1974-75 Sea rant Program.

Funds from other sources, including a \$300,000 appropriation from Texas' 63rd Legislature, bring the budget for the year to \$2,088,180 according to Dr. John C. Calhoun, Jr., vice president for academic affairs and director of the Sea Grant College Program.

Willis H. Clark, associate director, said the new federal grant is 25 percent greater than last year's

The program was enacted by Congress in 1966 to encourage wise development of marine resources through matching fund grants to universities, laboratories and other institutions


