

# Traffic panel talks about parking areas

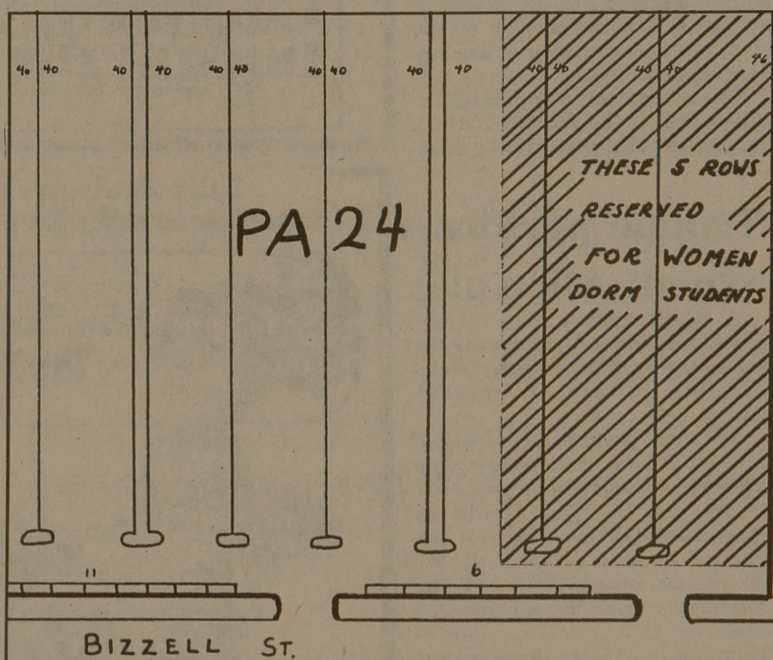
Motorcycle parking and what to do with FM 60 and Agronomy Road were discussed Wednesday afternoon in the Traffic Panel meeting.

The specific problem of cycle parking in lot 29 was considered and referred to further committee study under Chris Lawson.

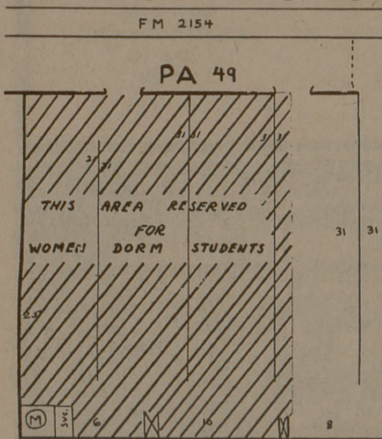
The first was to widen and resurface Agronomy Road up to the point where the new Purchase and Storage Building will stand. There was a discussion to extend Agronomy across FM 60 into the West Campus complex site.

Another recommendation was made to study the movement of bike traffic from the Vet Building traveling east. If enough traffic travels from the Vet Building to the central campus, a diagonal route may be suggested to help ease the traffic problem at the Wellborn overpass.

Other action taken was the distribution of maps showing where women dorm students may park. Also, 58 additional parking spaces are now available in Lot 9, behind Law Hall, for day student parking.



THESE MAPS DESIGNATE, by the use of diagonal stripes, where women dorm students are allowed to park. Chief O. L. Luther says that strict enforcement will go into effect Monday in these lots. The small numbers represent the number of spaces available for vehicle parking.

**TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY OFFICE OF THE DEAN OF ADMISSIONS AND RECORDS**  
To be eligible to purchase the Texas A&M undergraduate student must have at least one residence and credit for at least ninety-one hours. A year in residence may consist of a spring semester or one of the above and a fall semester (both the first and second terms). This session (both the first and second terms) passed at the preliminary grade report period, October 21, 1974 may be used in satisfying the hour requirement. Students qualifying under this provision should leave their names with the registrar, Richard Coke building. This should be done by October 21st in order for all records to be determined ring eligibility. Students who have completed ninety-two (92) completed hours on record at the time of the preliminary grade report period, starting October 24, 1974, and will continue to December 6, 1974, All rings must be placed when the order is placed. Students will receive their bring grade reports along when ready. Students who fail to leave their names in advance, asked to return later to allow times for credit checks. The rings are due to arrive at the Registrar's Office on January 25, 1975. All rings ordered prior to October 21st in order for all records to be determined ring eligibility. The ring check is from 8 a.m. to 12 noon and 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Monday through Friday. However, in order for the ring to be checked, orders must be placed prior to the closing of the office.
