The resolution adopted by consensus late Monday said the summit 'reaffirms the rights of the Palestinian people to set up an independent national authority, under the leadership of the PLO as the sole legitimate representative of the Palestinian people on any Palestinian land that is liberated. Arab countries must support this author-ity when it is established in all fields and at all levels.'

The Arab leaders did not specify who was to represent the West Bank Palestinians in negotiations with Israel but left it to Jordan, Egypt, Syria and the PLO "to establish a formula for organizing the relationship between them


