JC transfers shine

Two Junior College transfers led the Texas Aggies to a 84-77 victory against Houston Baptist College as they improved their season record to 2-0.

Sonny Parker, a two-year Junior College All-America transfer from Chicago, Ill., had 22 points and 13 rebounds to lead the Aggies in those two categories. Barry Davis, a JC

transfer from Galveston, Tex., was second high scorer and rebounder with 17 points and six caroms.

"Their halfcourt press in the second half caught us off guard," team captain John Thornton said. "It was a team effort keeping them off the boards." Thornton was third leading scorer for the Ags with nine points.

Chuck Tone and Mike Floyd both ended with eight points. Floyd has not missed a free throw this season,

extending his string to 10 straight. Jerry Mercer and Webb Williams both had six points and Cedric Joseph had five. Starting guard Gates Erwin did not play due to a hamstring injury. He is expected to

play in the game against Oral Roberts Saturday.

Paige led the scoring with 25 points, hitting five of five from the free throw line. Coleman was the second leading scorer for HBC with

15 points. The Huskies are now 0-3 for the season.

When the Ags did break away from their sloppy play, Parker usually led the way. His hustle and strong rebounding performance seem to assure A&M as a strong competitor in the Southwest Conference.

The Aggies seemed to be kept alive by the hustling of Parker and the turnovers of the Huskies. Houston Baptist had 31 turnovers to the Ags 18. But the Ags couldn't keep 6-11 Robert Paige and 6-9 Mack Coleman off the boards as they combined for 30 of HBC's 47 rebounds. The Ags could only muster 41 caroms, mainly due to sloppy play in the second half.

The Aggies only hit 42 percent from the field in the second half, but the Huskies hit a weak 37 percent in a game marred by 48 combined team fouls. The first half Aggie hustle turned into second half sloppiness.

"Whatever I can do to help the team, I'll do," Parker said. "Whether scoring or playing defense."

Lonnie Richards, head coach of HBC, said, "I felt we played good enough to win. I couldn't have asked any more of these kids."

Coach Shelby Metcalf of the Aggies said, "With the style we'll be playing, we'll have to use everybody. We'll play a lot of pressure defense this season."

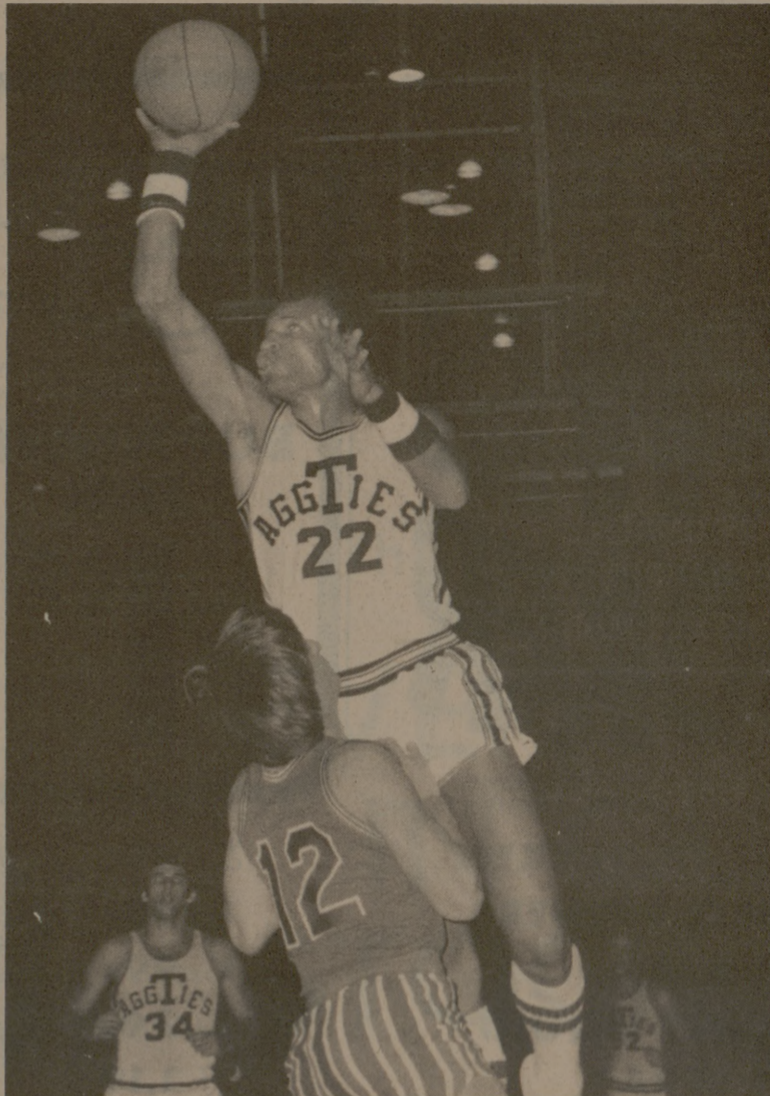
