### Added gran aids study of oxides

The effects on human lungson ides of sulfur suspended in thea industry or autos is getting ac

look from an A&M researcher. Dr. Jack Lunsford has b awarded an additional \$30,000 the Environmental Protect Agency to identify the cond under which sulfur oxides form the surface of airborne partic The particles are the product of emissions of burning coal or anylo

The professor said it is known these absorbed oxides of sul cause respiratory problems in h mans and animals

Dr. Lunsford is also searching the forms of oxides of sulfur.

"Current tests don't distingu between sulfate and sulfite ions said. "Air quality tests only givet total amount of sulfur presentas fate ions without distinguishing actual form of the sulfur oxide.

"Our research will show that tain ions are predominate und particular set of conditions, said. "This will then help the interpret the results of other search groups on the respiratory ritation.

Lunsford said he was using frared spectroscopy to determ the nature of chemical compound Aerosol type solids such as m

nesium oxide and actual atm pheric aerosol samples collecte various locations throughout state are being studied.
