The other is another spin-off of "All in the Family" called "The Jeffersons," solidly entrenched in CBS' Saturday comedy lineup that also includes top ten veterans such as "All in the Family," Mary Tyler Moore" and "Bob Newhart." "The Jeffersons" hovered around the number four spot in the Neilson ratings while "Hot l Balti-
