

# Ags picked to battle Horns for baseball crown

Hitters expected to make the Longhorns go are third baseman Keith Moreland, catcher Rick Bradley, designated hitter Mickey Reichenbach and shortstop Blair Stouffer.  
Moreland appeared in all Texas games and got 103 hits for a .399 average. He also led the country in the number of doubles with 25. Bradley hit .397 and belted 13 homers and drove in 66 runs while Reichenbach hit .301.  
Left-hander Richard Wortham 10-4, Martin Flores 6-1 and Frosty Moore 3-0 will help spell Cideon. If pitching seems to be a Longhorn plus then batting is an Aggie minus. The Aggies came out of the dugouts swinging last year and helped them post a 17-7 SWC record in the land. Their batting average was .342 second best in the land. They batted .345 last year in their first year at the helm with an even 12-12 SWC record.

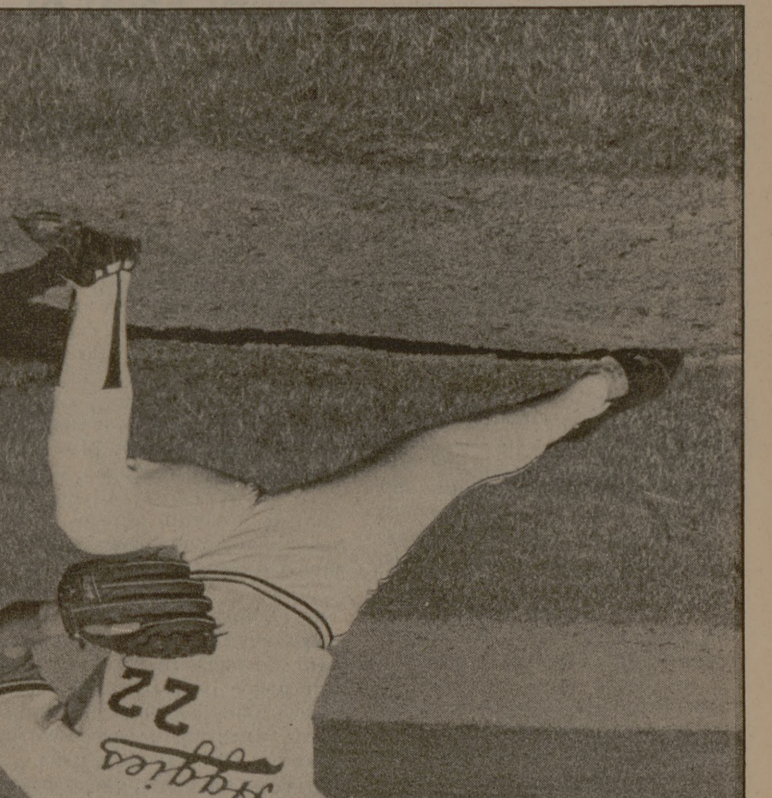
