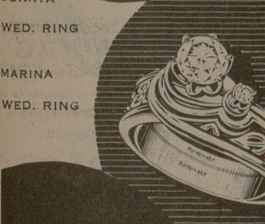

Rules and entry forms are available at the league's office at 3211 Texas Avenue, arts and crafts stores throughout the area and at the University Book Store.

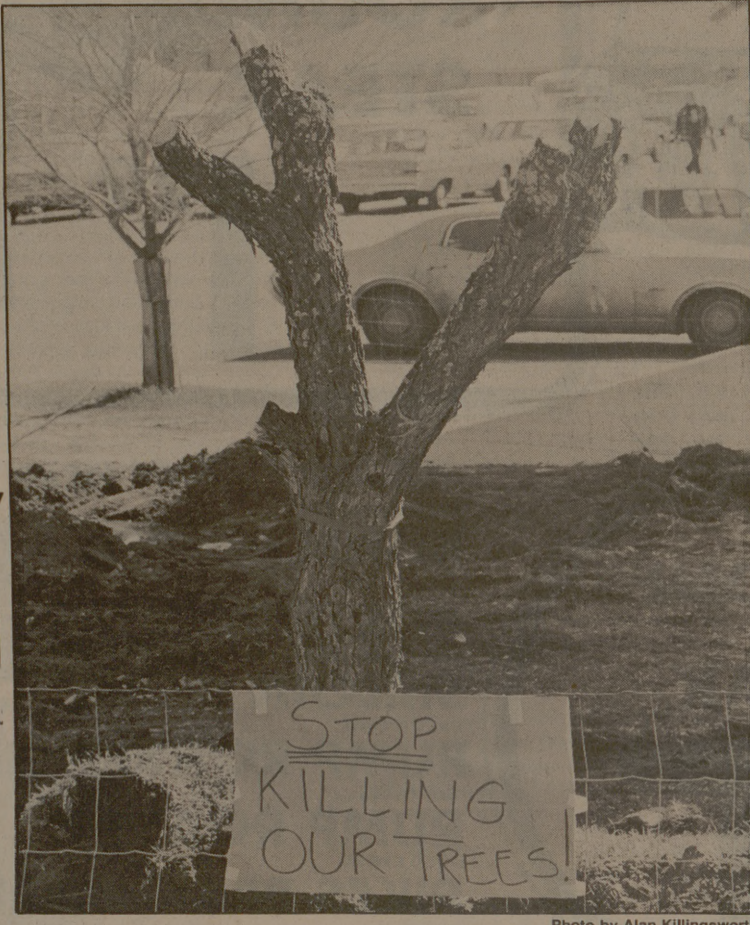
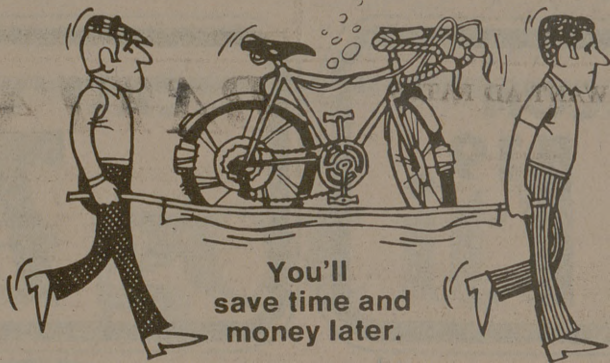

Unemployment up

Unemployment in the Bryan-College Station area continued to climb because of layoffs in manufacturing and construction and a decrease in retail sales, according to the Texas Employment Commission in its February report. The number of active jobseekers

reached 1,389 — up 8 per cent over last month and 28 per cent over last year, the report stated.

Job placement in non-agricultural positions totaled 259 in January compared to 324 in January 1974. Farm employment remained stable.
