GI speaker free choice economist

Economist Gordon Tullock continues the Great Issues Series Thursday at 8 p.m. in the Rudder Center Theater. Tullock will outline the socio-economic views of crime and lead up to the much talked about paradox — capital punishment, need or evil. Tullock is considered one of the most outstanding figures on the economics of crime. Presently a professor of Economics and Free Choice at Virginia Polytechnic Institute Center for Study of Public Choice, he received his law degree at the University of Chicago and has studied at several of the foremost universities. While serving in the United States Foreign Services he studied Chinese and related fields in Southeast Asia. Presently he is the editor of the journal "Public Choice". Admission is free to Tullock's exploration of choices in combating crime.

Appointment of colonel, deputy set

Joseph M. Chandler of San Antonio and Bill J. Helwig of Miles have been named to top student command posts in the 1975-76 Corps of Cadets. Chandler will be cadet colonel of the corps. Helwig will be deputy commander. They assume the posts May 10 at Final Review. Appointments were announced by Col. Thomas R. Parsons, commandant, with approval of TAMU President Jack K. Williams. Seniors serve as the Corps' officers. Juniors serve as cadet non-commissioned officers. The Aggie Corps provides a "leadership lab" for ROTC cadets and students who elect not to enter commissioning programs but desire the experience. Helwig is in the latter category, said Col. Parsons. He will be the first drills and ceremonies cadet to hold top corps rank. Chandler and Helwig will succeed Rickey Gray of Dallas and Granville "G II" Lasseter of Midland, respectively. Chandler, a junior zoology major, is corps sergeant major this year. An Army contract cadet, he is member of the Ross Volunteers and commanded the Fish Drill Team. Helwig is operations sergeant on the Corps staff this year. An agricultural economics major, he is also a Ross volunteer.

Traffic Panel motion restricts second permits

The University Traffic panel passed a motion March 5 to eliminate duplicate parking permits. The motion will be sent to Dr. John Koldus, vice president for student services, as the panel's recommendation for the 1975-76 vehicle regulations. The motion was prompted by violations of duplicate permit regulations and the difficulty of enforcement. Also discussed was the possibility of converting a picnic area by Throckmorton St. into a parking area for special events.

TAMU Press state art series receives money

A gift of \$75,000 to the new Texas A&M University Press has made possible a series of art books interpreting the various regions of Texas. Joe H. Moore, immediate past president of TAMU's Association of Former Students, and his wife Betty made the contribution. Frank H. Wardlaw, Texas A&M University Press director, said the first book in the Joe and Betty Moore Texas Art Series will be by Mondel Rogers from Sweetwater. He has made a series of paintings of more than 50 great ranches of the Texas High Plains. His book will be published in 1976. The second book in the Moore Series, to be published in 1977, will be an interpretation of the Texas Panhandle by Austin artist Michael Frary. The text of the Panhandle book will be written by Loula Grace Erdman of Amarillo. Proceeds from the sale of all books published in the Joe and Betty Moore Texas Art Series will go back into a revolving fund from which future books in the series will be published.
