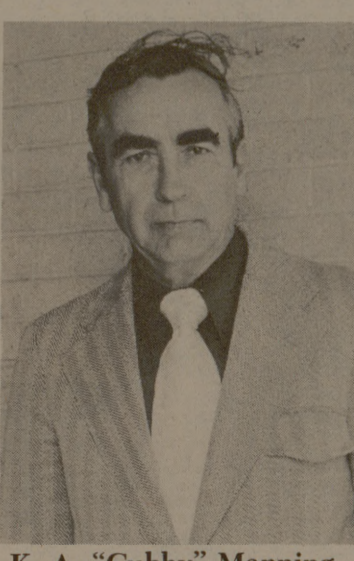
Women's council meets

Opposition creates bid withdrawal

AUSTIN (AP) — At the appointee's request, Gov. Dolph Briscoe withdrew his nomination Wednesday of Ford Albritton Jr. of Bryan to the Texas College Coordinating Board.
 Albritton's letter asking for the withdrawal said that Sen. Peyton McKnight, D-Tyler, apparently had enough votes to block the appointment, so further debate would simply harm the coordinating board.
 McKnight once served with Albritton as a Texas A&M regent, but has never revealed publicly his reasons for opposing Albritton's confirmation by the Senate.
