# Castro murder 'considered'

Richard Bissell, who directed the agency's covert foreign operations from 1959 to 1962, said Monday that he told the Rockefeller Commission investigating the CIA that the assassination of Castro "was considered.

Bissell spoke to a reporter after testifying before the commission. Vice President Nelson A. Rock-

efeller, head of the eight-member panel investigating allegations of CIA domestic wrongdoing, declined to confirm Bissell's tes-

Instead, the vice president repeated earlier statements that the commission would investigate alleged assassination plots only if they violated domestic statutes.

Most recently, convicted Watergate burglar Frank Sturgis said in a interview with the New York Daily News that he was part of a CIA plot to assassinate Castro in 1960. Sturgis said the attempt was never made because officials in Washington "couldn't make up their minds."

Bissell, who resigned as deputy CIA director for plans following the Bay of Pigs, said he did not know whether President Kennedy was aware of the CIA discussions about killing Castro.

Informed sources say that the Rockefeller commission is investigating whether the CIA withheld information from the Warren Commission during that panel's investigation into the assassination of President Kennedy. Reports have suggested that the CIA may have resisted furnishing information to the Warren Commission in an effort to cover up CIA involvement in

The conspirators planned to overthrow the Panamanian government and grab the canal, after blocking it with a sunken ship, "for propaganda and extortion reasons," it was said. Aiding in the scheme were Dame

Margot and her husband, Roberto Arias, former Panamanian ambassador to Britain and the son of a former president of Panama, the story said. The couple was assigned to bury arms and munitions on a beach, so they would be available to the plotters, according to the News.

RECORDS

To be eligible to purchase the Texas A&M ring, an undergraduate student must have at least one year in residence and credit for at least ninety-two (92) semester hours. A year in residence may consist of the fall and spring semesters or one of the above and a full summer session (both the first and second terms). The hours passed at the preliminary grade report period on March 12, 1975 may be used in satisfying this ninety-two hour requirement. Students qualifying under this regulation should leave their names with the ring clerk, room seven, Richard Coke Building. This should be done prior to March 12th in order for all records to be checked to determine ring eligibility. Students already having ninety-two (92) completed hours on record may order at any time since regular orders are sent in at the end of each month. Graduate students are eligible to order with proof (receipt) that they have filed for graduation.
