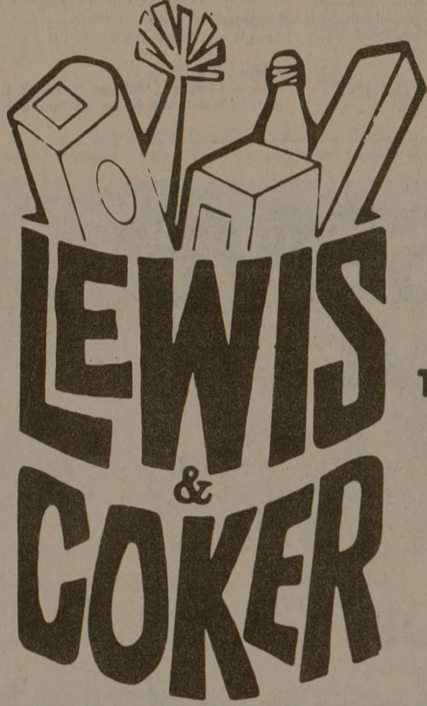

Bryan's 6th annual net tournament set

The Bryan & Recreation Department will sponsor the Sixth Annual City of Bryan Tennis Tournament on June 27, 28, and 29, 1974. Matches will be scheduled on the following courts: Williamson Park, Tanglewood Park, Haswell Park, Stephen F. Austin High School, Bryan High School, and the Texas A&M Varsity Courts. Matches will begin at 6:00 p.m. on Friday, June 27th.

The entry fee will be \$2.25 per person per event. The fees will be applied to the cost of the trophies. Trophies will be awarded to first, second, and consolation winners in each of 32 events. Thirty-two consolation tournaments will be run simultaneously one for each event. A sportsmanship trophy will be awarded to the participant exhibiting the best sportsmanship on and off the court.

- The 32 events are as follows:
- A. Men's (Singles & Doubles)
 - B. Women's (Singles & Doubles)
 - C. Mixed Doubles
 - D. Junior Veteran Men over 35 (Singles & Doubles)
 - E. Junior Veteran Women over 35 (Singles & Doubles)
 - F. Veterans over 35 (Mixed Doubles)
 - G. Veteran Men over 45 (Singles & Doubles)
 - H. Veteran Women over 45 (Singles & Doubles)
 - I. Senior Veteran Men over 55 (Singles & Doubles)
 - J. Boys and Girls 18 and under (Singles & Doubles)
 - K. Boys and Girls 16 and under (Singles & Doubles)
 - L. Boys and Girls 14 and under (Singles & Doubles)
 - M. Boys and Girls 12 and under (Singles & Doubles)
- Only participants in A & B may play in C. Only participants in D through I may play in F. Participants may enter only two (2) events. The two events must be in the same division. There are five (5) divisions:
- Division I A-I
 - Division II J
 - Division III K
 - Division IV L
 - Division V M

All participants must be citizens of Brazos County. To enter the tournament an individual must appear IN PERSON in the Parks & Recreation Office (Corner of Atkins and Fountain Streets) and register. Registration will take place during the entire month of May. Participants are encouraged to register during May since they will be unable to register before or after this period of time. To register you will need \$2.25 per person per event. Please bring the correct change.

One and one half hours have been scheduled for each match. In any set when a 6-6 tie occurs a nine point breaker will be played. A match will consist of 2 out of 3 sets. Each participant will furnish two new Wilson or Spalding tennis balls for each event in which he is entered. The winner will keep the unused balls after each match.

Ag keglers place first at Houston

The Texas A&M Bowling team placed first at the recent Texas Intercollegiate Bowling Conference (TIBC) Tournament at the University of Houston's Cougar Lanes. The Aggies, who held a three game lead going into the tournament, lost their first three games to second place Houston. The Cougars averaged 202 per man, totaling 3043.

The two teams won their next three games, bringing the season down to the final three games. Led by John Chappins' 248, the Aggies won the opener, while the Cougars took the second. Down by 60 pins (6 marks) in the sixth frame, A&M came back to take the lead by 30 pins (2 marks) going into the tenth frame.

The final player, Larry Galvin, doubled in the tenth giving the Aggies the win. Ray Mott (210) and Joe Tomilson (200) were high men for the Aggies in that final game.

The Aggies averaged over 184 per man, totaling 8319 pins for the day. Individuals and their scores include Larry Galvin (197), Ray Mott (195), Don Ledford (192), John Chappins (186), Ray Scott (183), Joe Tomilson (172), Mitch Smith (168) and Jim Adams (151). The win is the second consecutive TIBC championship for A&M. The Aggies previously finished third for the 1972-1973 season.

The Aggies also sent a team to Corpus Christi, April 19-20 for the first annual Texas Intercollegiate Bowling Tournament, which won the team trophy which stands 4 feet 6 inches. The team included Doug Ocker, Larry Galvin, Bill Ketter, Mitch Smith and Joe Tominson.
