

"The final draft was presented to the President two or three months ago and within the past couple of weeks he signed the bill. Our conference reacted to these guidelines and expressed some concern about some of the points in the proposed guidelines," Dr. Samson said.

"There needs to be a single group, but the women should have an appropriate voice," Dr. Samson said. 'I believe it's their concern that if the NCAA simply absorbs their program, they would not have a repre-

Dr. Samson explained that the conference took no action this past time. 'Members have not really had a chance to study the NCAA proposal, so no action has been taken beyond that of a year ago.

'As fas as the SWC stands," he said, it's been my observation that the conference hasn't been inclined as a conference to take over women's athletics. This has been a concern of many women throughout the

"We have not taken any strong steps to assume the responsibility of women's athletics," Dr. Samson added. "In fact, I think that many if not all of us question if this would be desirable.
