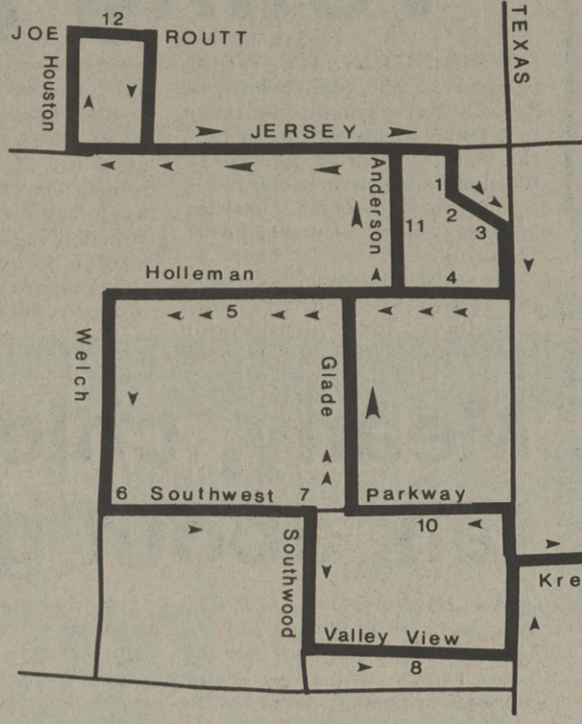
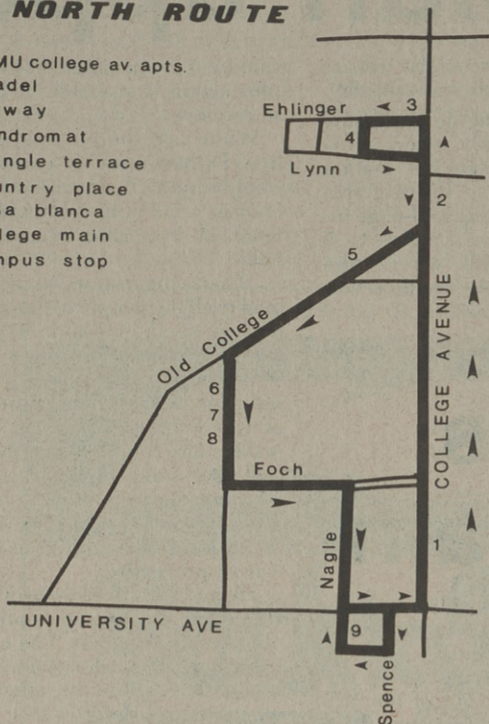

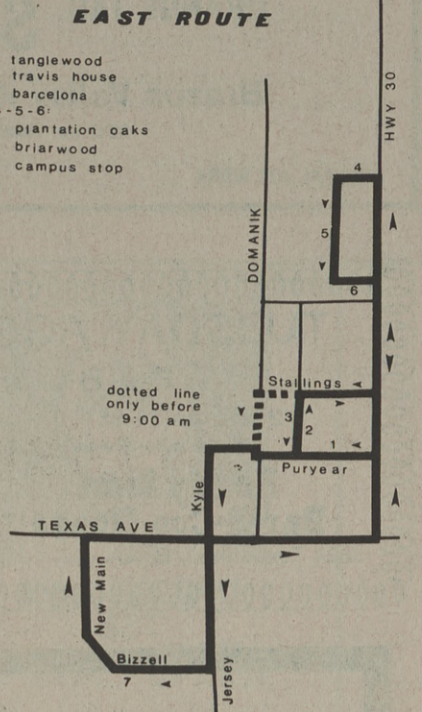

The TAMU Shuttle Bus system has an additional bus for the 1975-76 school year and new routes designed to meet the needs of as many off-campus students as possible.

To utilize the improved service, a University bus pass or one-ride ticket is required of all passengers. It must be shown to the driver when boarding the bus. Both passes the one-ride tickets are available at the fiscal office.

All three of the revised routes will begin service at 7 a.m.

Service for the North route is scheduled for every 20 minutes, with the last bus leaving the campus at 5:40 p.m. After that time, there is a station wagon evening service until 10:40 p.m. available by calling the Physical Plant Department at 845-4311.

The South route is scheduled to have service every 15 minutes until 5 p.m. and every 25 minutes thereafter. The last bus leaves the campus at 10:40 p.m.

For the East route, it is planned to have a bus every 10 minutes until 5 p.m. and every 20 minutes after that until 10:40 p.m.

Passengers of the Shuttle Bus are required to enter by the front door and leave through the rear door of the bus. Passengers will only be picked up and left at stops designated on the route maps.

tion are being tested now. This water contains hydrogen sulfide because foul-smelling gas was released from the well when sampling reached that depth.

The hydrogen sulfide can be removed from the water by an aeration process if the total dissolved solids count does not exceed the maximum allowable.

The well is located at the city's ground storage site at the intersection of University Drive and Tarrow Street.

place a note under the windshield of your car stating the circumstances and the time. You will be granted a 15-minute reprieve, after which time you must move your vehicle.

The other recourse you have is to appeal any traffic citations that you receive to the Traffic Appeals Panel. You must report to the police station within seven days after receipt of the notice, and they will schedule your appeal. On the day of your appeal, you will appear before a panel of five to seven students, who will hear your case and vote upon the validity of the ticket.

Of course, there is still a third way to beat the parking ticket racket... try parking in the appropriate area at all time and following the regulations that have been set.
