In 1974, the woman athletes of Texas A&M University received an All Sports trophy from the Texas Association of Intercollegiate Athletes for Woman. The trophy is given annually to the top three schools accumulating the most points during the competitive season. A&M currently shares the trophy with the University of Texas at Austin and Texas Woman's University.

"We have a very young program," says Miss Kay Don, Assistant Athletic Director for Women. "Our girls have only been in competition
