## Soccer team ousts SFA, 3-2, increase season record to 3-1

The Soccer team bounced back to its only loss of the young season to bounce Stephen F. Austin, in Nacogdoches on Saturday. After losing a hard fought game to defending champs of the Texas Collegiate Soccer League from University of Houston a week (6-2), the Aggs upped their record to 3-1.

Showing form typical of the Aggs of Coach Kurt Irgolic in games led so far this season, the team dominated the game but had trouble scoring.

The Aggs took a 2-1 lead in the 11th minute of the first half. Arturo was the first to score for Texas A&M University, but found his goal five minutes later when SFA tied the score on a corner kick. Mayer put the Aggs up again on an unreachable shot from 30 yards out.

In a much tighter second half the Aggs just managed to maintain position of the scoreboard and escape a win. Both teams scored one in the final 45-minute period.

Doing the honors for A&M was Cherrak. Cherrak put the

head on a well-placed corner kick for the winning goal. The Aggie defense played very strong bolstered by superb goalkeeping by Hank Arnold.
