a dangerous precedent for future senate action. A legislative body should never support a measure unless they have done adequate research on the matter. Who's to say

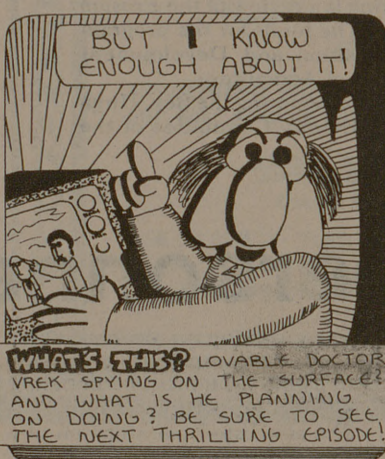
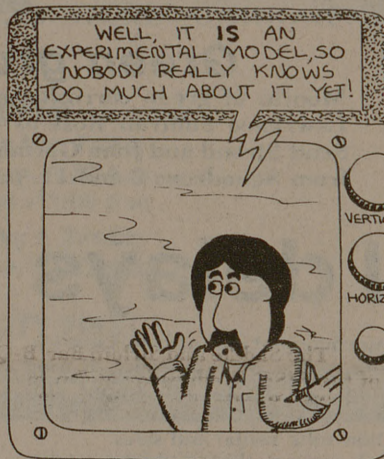
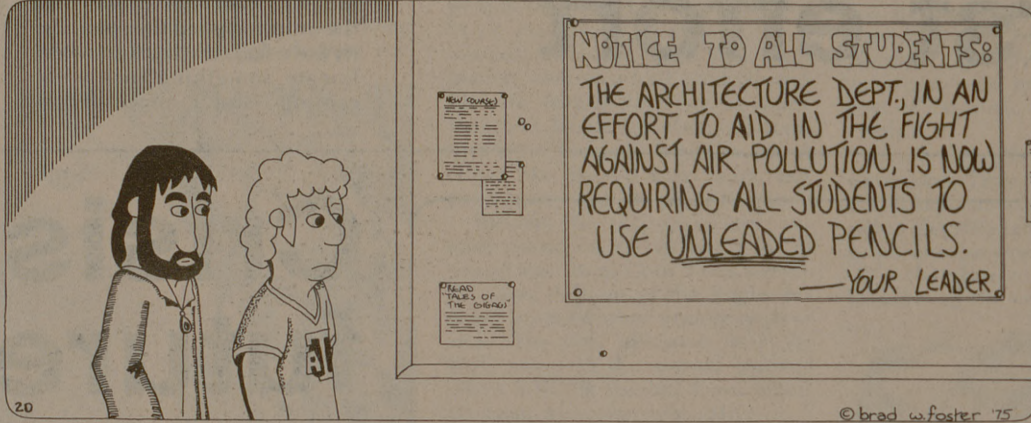
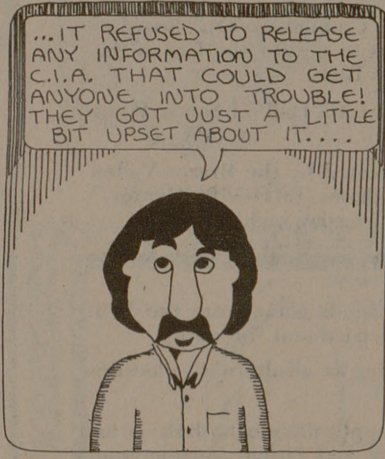
that the senate is not proposing to support the wrong group at UT. The individual senators should also see it as their duty to know the feeling of their constituency before

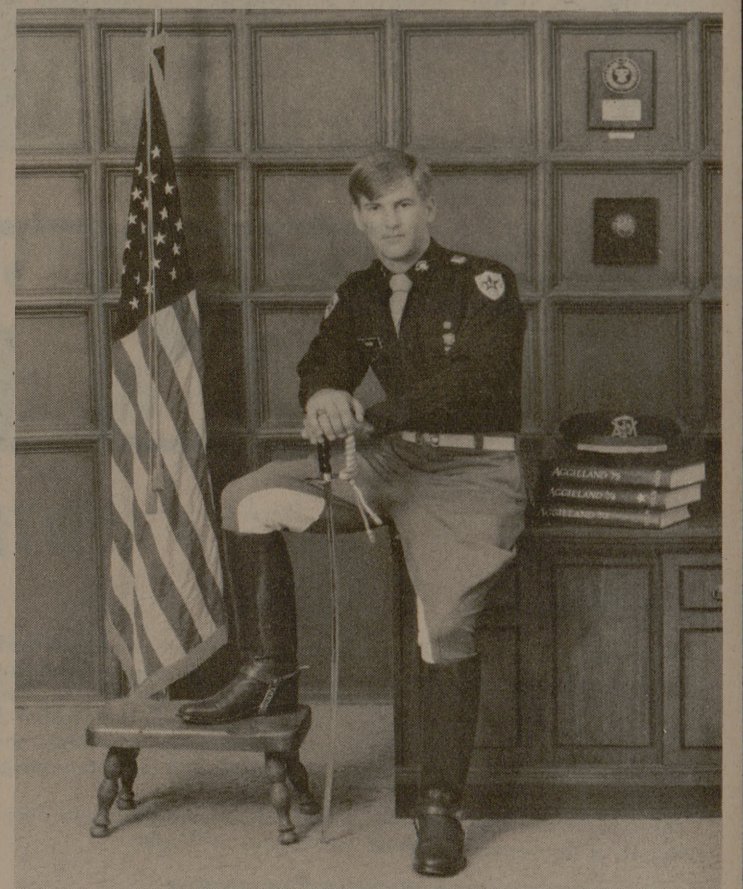

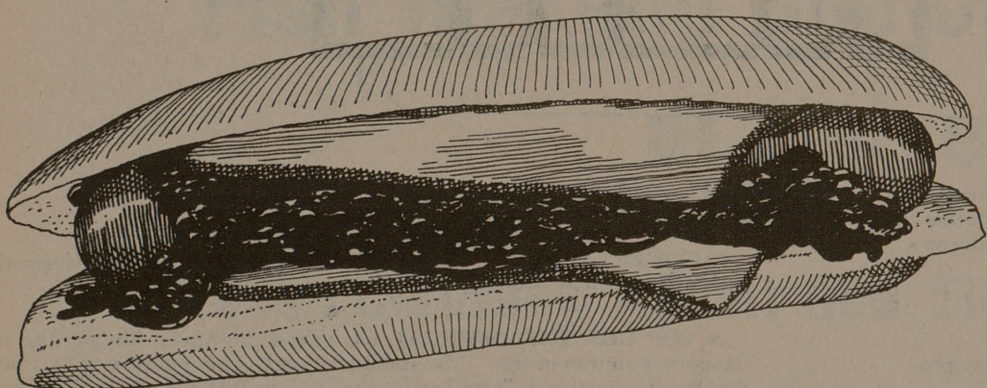
