Rushing records fall

Bean now all-time leader

The name Bubba Bean was etched solidly into the Texas A&M record books on Saturday, Oct. 11, 1975 with 8:19 left showing on the clock in the third quarter of the Southwest Conference opener for A&M against Texas Tech in Lubbock.

Bean showed he was more than

just any ball-carrier in school history with a superb 94-yard dash that lifted him to the throne of all-time A&M career rusher as well as bumping him up two places on the all-time SWC list to the No. 8 spot, as well as setting a record for the longest scoring play from scrimmage in the 81-year history of football at this University. (breath!) He almost didn't make it.

"Bujnoch cut off the safety. When I saw all that open field for some reason, I started laughing. I hyperventilated and when I got to the endzone, I almost passed out. If it had been ten yards farther, I wouldn't have made it," said Bean.

With his 180 yard, eight carry and therefore 20-yards per carry effort on Saturday, Bean now has

2,469 career yards, 54 more than previous leader Bob Smith who compiled his record over three years, 1949-51. Bean replaced Smith as the No. 8 man on the SWC list.

His long run also wiped out the previous long-scoring record from scrimmage also held by Bob Smith who went 81 yards against Tech in 1949. The Ags went on to win that game 26-7.

Bean wasn't one to talk of records, though. "I wish I could have broken it at home. But I hadn't given it much thought. I felt I would get it sooner or later." What was important was winning the game Bean, said.

Bean also had a scoring run of 47 yards earlier in the game on the same play, a pitchout on the right side, with Bujnoch leading the blocking duties with the right side linemen.

There are some others still chasing the rushing king, also.

Halfback Skip Walker now has 1,665 yards and needs 72 more to pass up Larry Stegent for the No. 3 spot behind Bean and Smith.

Bucky Sams with his 25-yard effort at Tech moved past Jack Pardee and Wendell Housley to take over the No. 9 spot with 1,031 yards.

Richard Osborne took in another pass and needs two more to pass Bob Long for the career receptions No. 2 spot. He needs 10 more yards to pass Homer May for the No. 3 spot in all-time receiving yards.

game after a controversial call which left the Lamar goalie injured. Before recuperating from the loss and playing a man short, the Ags found themselves tied at 3-3.

Paul Oliver took the situation into his own hands, pulling from defense to the front to save the game for the Ags with five minutes left.

The win leaves the Aggies with a 4-1 record this season, the best in several years. This weekend they will travel to Houston where they take on League champs UH and Rice. The Ags only loss so far this season was to UH.

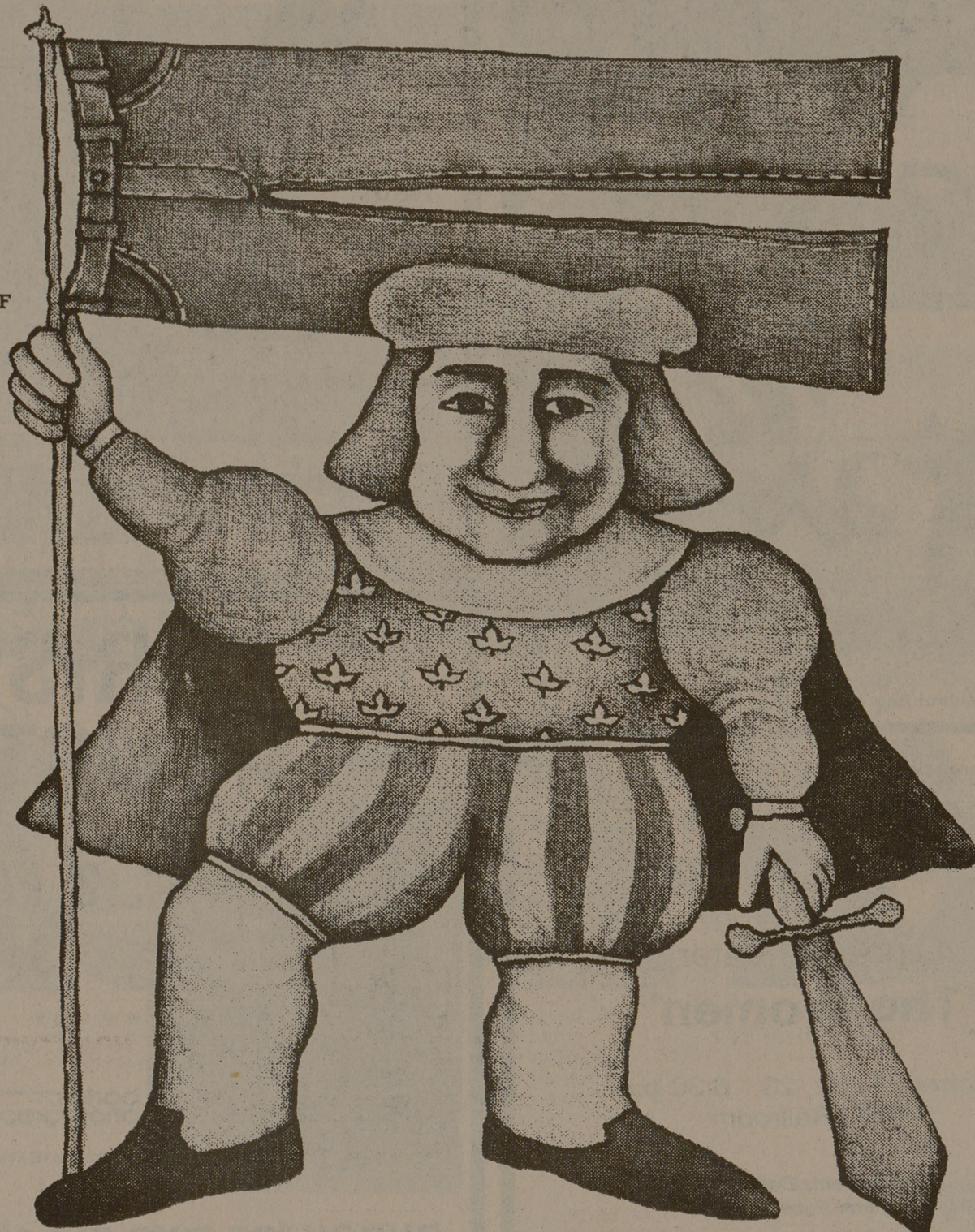
