He maintained underground contact with other camps for resistance and information purposes. He was also instrumental in organizing escape groups. It was Vasovski who managed the successful escape of two American prisoners who later, in 1945, advised advancing American forces of the camp's location.

These humanitarian actions and

the efforts of many of Vasovski's patients enabled him to immigrate to Congressional position the United States. He was admitted in 1949 and naturalized in 1953. He entered the U.S. Air Force in September 1949.

When he thought about registering at A&M, Vasovski said, "I had some reservations (about registering at A&M) at first, but I went through the whole rigamarole.
