> - Common Cause chairman John Gardner said Reagan is the only major candidate who has not revealed his personal financial status. He said that Reagan "will be haunted by it for months to come" unless he discloses his finances.

Reagan's press secretary, Lyn Nofziger, said Reagan has decided not to enter Pennsylvania's April 27

primary, partly because delegates there run uncommitted and may vote for any candidate at the national convention. Pennsylvania also has a presidential preference section on its primary ballot but that has no effect on delegate selection, and Nofziger said Reagan feels he has little to gain by opposing Ford there.

Democratic candidate R. Sargent Shriver told a Boston news conerence that he has learned that the Soviet Union has revised its policies to permit families with defense secrets to emigrate. He said he had intervened as a private citizen in behalf of a number of people in the Soviet Union, and he criticized the Ford administration for not bargaining

with the Russians on emigration.

— Sen. Henry M. Jackson,
D-Wash. pledged to reopen the Boston Navy Yard if he is elected, saying the United States is falling "farther and farther behind the Soviet Union in seapower." Jackson issued a position paper which said the Soviet navy has become "a major force on the high seas. We are falling behind, and other countries are gaining rapidly at

our expense."
