pool is now carrying," Landiss said. Funds for improvements in the natatorium come from the available funding the same as any other build-

ing on campus," Landiss said.

The walls in the natatorium have been painted and new lighting installed, Fosdick said, but he feels that the pool is not meeting the standards

"It is too shallow around the diving wells," he said. The depth around the wells is nine feet, but a 12foot depth around the boards is the bare minimum, Fosdick said.
"Even at 12 feet divers still hit the

bottom. SMU refuses to bring their divers to our swim meets now after one of their divers split his head open during a meet."
Fosdick said that several A&M

swimmers have been injured on the boards during practice as well as a diver from Rice who split his chin on the bottom of the diving wells.

Wofford Cain pool is 50 meters long which is the size of an olympic

pool. The diving well for the towers at the pool is 16 feet deep.

"The diving wells at the University of Texas pool are 23 feet deep and those at TCU are about 26 feet deep," Fosdick said.

"I think the outdoor pool is in fine condition," Landiss said. "We are in the process of replacing the heating system, but it takes time for the requests to go through." quests to go through.

The funding for the outdoor pool comes from student services fees and fees charged faculty and staff mem-

bers for their use of the pool.

A scoreboard and PA system were bought for the pool by the water polo
