At present, only a few colleges offer the honors courses in their curriculums, Spiller said.

The present regulations at A&M state that a student with a grade point average of 3.25-3.49 will graduate Cum Laude, 3.5-3.749 Magna Cum Laude and 3.750 or above Summa Cum Laude.

"The purpose of the study is to see how valuable a degree with honors is and to increase the academic standards to keep from making A&M a diploma factory," said Keith Merrick, committee member.
