

Jersey Street-Wellborn Road Light installation to begin

Long-awaited installation of traffic signals at the intersection of Jersey Street and Wellborn Road will begin by the end of next month, Bockman, Texas Highway Department resident engineer for the project, said. The Ft. Worth contract was awarded to the Blackburn Electric Service, which received the equipment for the traffic signal manufacturer. The contract was awarded the \$27,497 by the THD in November. The signals, they (Blackburn) will be installed within the next 30 to 45 days, depending on when they receive the equipment," Bockman said. Blackburn has installed

led traffic signals at 18 intersections on Texas Avenue between State Highway 21, north of Bryan, and University Drive (FM 60) in College Station at a combined cost of \$269,000.

The THD already has widened a stretch of the Wellborn Road just south of Jersey Street to include four lanes plus a left turn lane. Wellborn Road is four lanes wide from north of Jersey Street to the University Drive overpass.

Bockman said traffic traveling north and south on Wellborn Road will be protected by the signal when turning left onto Jersey Street from either direction. Traffic turning left onto Wellborn Road from Jersey Street will not be protected, he said.

Bockman said the THD has received authorization from the Texas Highway Commission to install traffic signals on South College Avenue in Bryan at the following intersections: Villa Maria, Sulphur Springs Road, Old College Road and North Avenue.

Traffic signal installation projects scheduled for College Station include: University Drive at East 29th Street, Texas Avenue at Holleman and Old Main Drive at the Wellborn Road, just west of the Texas A&M campus.

These seven installations will be federally funded with grant of \$146,800 under the 1975 Urban Systems Act. Contracts will be let later this year, Bockman said.

Recognized organizations' campus advertising prohibited

Handbill says "Summer Jobs Available" and advertises excellent opportunities for student job hunters.

The leaflet, lying on a table in the library, is an example of advertising that is prohibited on the Texas A&M campus.

Organizations not recognized by the University cannot advertise on campus except by direct mail, phone, or in The Battalion.

This fall, an ad hoc committee was appointed by Vice President of Student Services John Koldus, to study the problem of advertising. The committee, composed of students, faculty and staff, wanted to review every advertising item used on campus, said Ron Blatchley, assistant director of Student Affairs. It eventually decided to establish basic guidelines and pass them on to other University departments, he said.

Many departments follow just the guidelines, while others add more stipulations. One of the organizations with additional requirements is the Memorial Student Center. The Building Studies Committee of the MSC Council has recently passed measures stating that all ad material posted in the MSC must be approved by the student programs office. Staff member Don Rohel has the responsibility of excluding any-

thing that is not from University organizations.

Enforcement of the rules around campus is not organized in any manner other than departmental discretion, Blatchley said.

Blatchley said he personally takes down any non-university ads he sees and has contacted several businesses to inform them of the violations.

Some of them feel that they have the right to advertise on campus, he said, but the University just does not have the room.
