

SG has, however, tried to persuade the administration to approve liquor on campus for special occasions and dances to increase attendance at such functions. Even though the conditions for such occasions would be very strict and supervised, the administration's response has been nega-

SG has also been working on a referenlege Station from 12 to 2 a.m. on Fridays and Saturdays. Dunn said the referendum passed the Student Senate and has now gone to the College Station City Council for approval. If the council votes yes on it, the referendum will go into effect as a city ordi-

To get the policy on alcoholic beverages changed on campus, the process is a long and tedious one, Dunn said. The issue must first pass the student senate. It is then given to the vice presidents for comment and next sent to the Academic Council.

If the council approves the issue, they make a recommendation to Williams and upon his approval, he makes a recommendation to the Board of Regents. If the Board accepts the issue, it becomes university




