## Briscoe to propose measu cutting 'good-time' senten

COMMERCE, Tex. — Gov. Dolph Briscoe said Wednesday he will propose to the state legislature a bill calling for the elimination of good-time credit for persons convicted of certain felonies.

The governor made the announcement in a luncheon speech during the last day of the Sam Rayburn Public Affairs symposium in Commerce.

Current law allows a prison to receive up to 60 days of credit for each 30 days served based on good behavior. A prison is eligible for parole after having served one third of his sentence, including good-time credit.

Briscoe also wanted voluntary oral confessions admitted as trials.

Another measure will allow the state to remove drunk and chronic traffic violators from streets and highways of the state because those violators are a cause of traffic fatalities.

"I pledge to you and all of the citizens of Texas that I am totally committed to turning the tide against the criminal elements in our state," as he explained a series of proposals to deal with street violence.

Among the most important measures to be proposed is one calling for the elimination of good-time credit for persons convicted of murder, aggravated robbery, aggravated kidnapping, aggravated rape or crimes involving the use of a firearm.

He cited statistics that indicate that 67 per cent of offenders released from prison were arrested again within three years.
