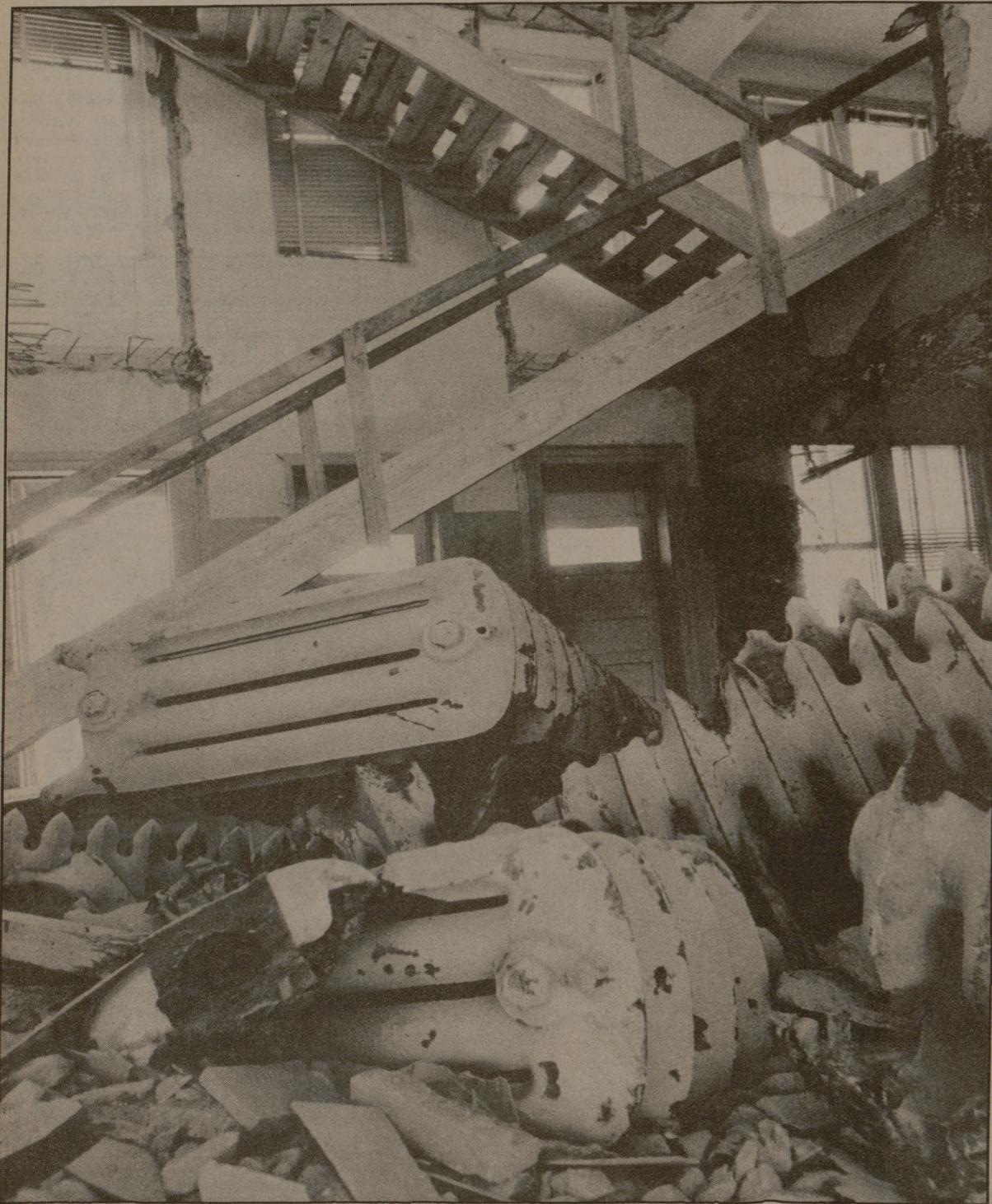


Milner Hall remodeling underway

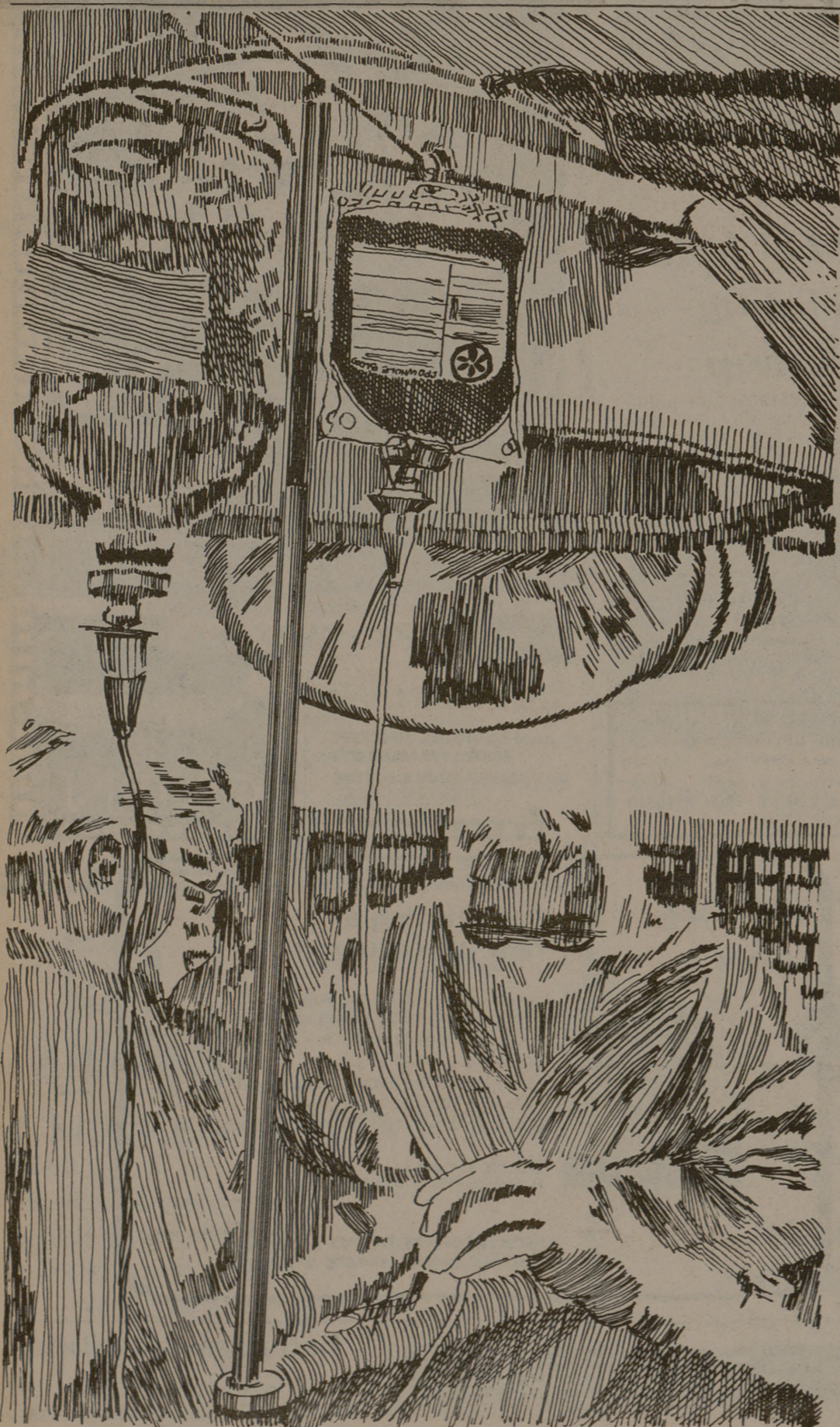


Although the radiators (above), which are piled on the bottom floor of Milner Hall, will never generate heat again, they still manage to keep very warm with the
