## Fire protection leaders attend conference

A national conference to define a fire officials executive development course began yesterday at Texas A&M University.

A grant was provided by the National Fire Protection and Control Administration of the U. S. Department of Commerce to assemble the conference.

Curtis M. Burns, EDP assistant director, said the conference has two basic objectives. It seeks to determine what problems in fire department management can be helped by executive development training and to identify resources, institutional and individual, that can be brought to bear on the problems.

Fire officials arrived Monday from Illinois, Oregon, Massachusetts, California, Washington, New York and Oklahoma. They include Houston Chief Joseph Perino.

Small group discussions center on human relations-communication, personnel-labor relations, administration-decision-making and budget-finance.
