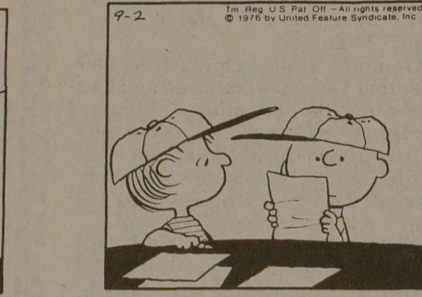
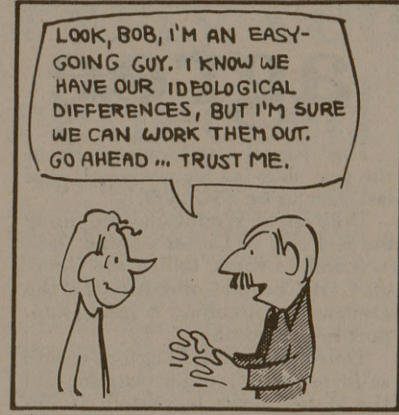
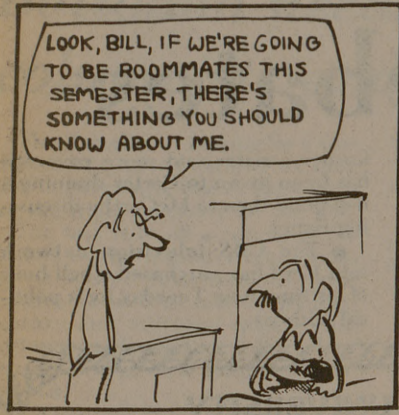

 AUSTIN — Government files of affirmative action complaints and Equal Employment Opportunity Commission reports must be opened upon request, Atty. Gen. John Hill ruled Wednesday.
 His open records opinion went to Houston City Attorney Otis H. King.
 Hill said government bodies must disclose upon request the names, sex, ethnicity, salaries, job titles, and dates of employment of employees and officials.
 The attorney general said results of complaint investigations completed by Houston's affirmative action office also are subject to mandatory disclosure.

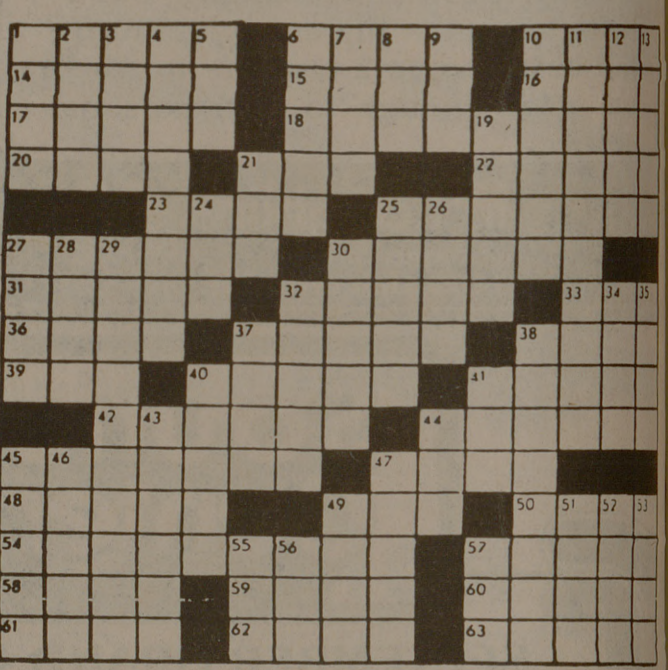
