The panel, made up of both students and faculty members, is appointed by the president of A&M and reports to the vice-president for

The purpose of the Traffic Panel is to make recommendations to the university regarding vehicle and bicycle regulations and restrictions,

"The panel is advisory, relating to policy. We do not make decisions; ve make recommendations," said Dr. Virgil Stover, who was chairman of the panel for the past three years.

"We do not go into itsy-bitsy de-tail," he continued. "The panel serves as a source of information for what will eventually result in administrative decision

Stover pointed out that the main area of problems concerns motor vehicle regulations. A subcommittee is appointed every year to make any revisions in the regulations that seem to be necessary, such as changes in wording, allocation of parking space or the amount of the

A draft of these revisions is taken to the Traffic Panel, which (providing the revisions are approved) recommends them to the adminis-


