Senate Majority Leader Mike Mansfield, 73, who has spent more than three decades in Congress, is spending his last day in the U.S. Senate today.

Mansfield, who earlier this year decided not to seek another term, will leave after today to visit the People's Republic of China for a work and study session and won't return before the Oct. 2 end of the congressional session.
