Book contest scheduled

Texas A&M students have started preparations for the fourth Student Book Collectors Contest of the University Library. The contest, which has a Nov. 5 entry deadline, offers \$850 in prizes. Winners will be announced at a Nov. 19 awards ceremony. Fort Worth collector and attorney Jennings Garrett will be speaker, says Irene Hoadley, libraries director. The contest is sponsored by the Friends of the Texas A&M University Library.

Students enrolled this semester may compete for prizes, including eight \$100 awards contributed by library friends and two \$25 honorable mentions. Rules require 25 titles representative of the collection to be entered, along with an annotated bibliography and a short statement describing the collection. A display on the first floor of the library details contest entry procedures. Brochures with rules and an entry blank are available throughout the library.
