A goal of \$142,726 has been set for the drive, representing a 5 per cent increase over the previous year's goal, according to Ed Holley, general chairman.

"We are confident that the people of Bryan and Brazos County will respond generously to this appeal," Holley said. "Our community goal is far less than other cities of comparable size and income level—Lufkin, Vicoria, Denton and Temple, for example. Yet the needs of this community are not less than the needs of other cities.
