Death toll could reach 80
Australian commuter train derail

SYDNEY, Australia — A crowded commuter train derailed into a 100-ton bridge today, collapsing it in an avalanche of concrete that trapped hundreds of screaming passengers under tons of rubble and crushed two cars.

it "the worst disaster Sydney has had."
Gas leaking from a ruptured line hampered rescue workers trying to reach the trapped survivors.
"One naked flame and this place would be blown sky high," said a member of the gas company's emergency squad.

Emergency squads tore the wooden carriages apart with pneumatic drills, chain saws and their bare hands but the leaking gas overcame several rescue workers and slowed their work.
Dr. Peter Christopher, in charge of the rescue medical team, said, "We are locating people by tapping on the side of the carriage. People are either tapping back or calling their names out."

for them. Two doctors have managed to crawl inside part of the third carriage to give five people we know are injections of morphine.
"The coach has been squashed down to a height of about two feet. The chances of more than a handful of people surviving that are very remote," he said.

Standing at the edge of the lapsed overpass, New South Wales Premier Neville Wran said: "God, it's unbelievable."
