
Hellriegel has business experience as an associate staff analyst for Cleveland Electric Illuminating Co. and was co-owner of a private business in Boulder, Colo.

## Lab's delay left tug crew in blast area

United Press International HOUSTON — An Exxon employee testified that a tugboat which sank in an oil tanker explosion was waiting for permission to leave the area at the time of the blast.

Dock technician James E. Orms testified yesterday before a Coast Guard inquiry that the Nathan B had completed its work near the tanker San Francisco.

"We were just waiting on the lab," he said. "That's why the tug was still there."

As the Nathan B waited, a loading arm from the barge to the ship broke and sprayed the tanker, dock and tug with fuel. The fuel ignited causing several explosions and fires aboard the tanker and on the dock. The tug sank immediately, taking its three crewmen with it.

Before the formal hearing began, witnesses said it appeared the fire started about the same time the tug started up its engines, leading to speculation that an engine spark had ignited the fuel.

The tugboat captain, Dale Wolfred, and two crewmen, Ruffin Hardin and Wendell Drodgy, died in the accident. Nine other workers were injured. One was hospitalized and has been released.

Testimony is expected to require most of the week with a final report due in five to eight months away, said Lt. Cmdr. Stanley Spurgeon, the hearing officer.

Exxon has not released an estimate of the damage to the dock, barge or tanker. But the tank departed for Boston Friday, and the dock is closed.
