

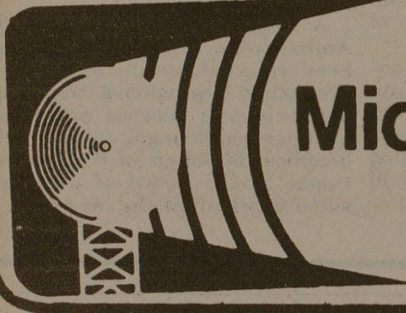

Aggies get experience, fly in Phantom jets

A Texas A&M University senior and junior have a unique flying experience coming Monday, if they believe a sophomore and freshman who've already been there.

The experience is an orientation ride in an Air Force RF-4C Phantom.

"I told Lt. Col. (Lee) McCleskey (project officer) if neither of them want to go next Monday, I'm available," one of the first two fliers said.

Sophomore Mark Hryhorchuk of Bridge City and freshman Gregory

Dew of Freeport flew last Monday, courtesy of the 12th Air Force at Bergstrom AFB.

Senior Richard J. Ingenloff of San Antonio and junior Terrance J. Stanislav of Allen don pressure suits for Feb. 14 flights.

Arranged by Lt. Gen. James D. Hughes, 12th Air Force commander, the four orientation flights were first planned with Col. Robert Elkins here as 30 to 45 minute rides. The flights were about an hour and 45 minutes.

The Air Force ROTC cadets each logged 2.3 hours. They saw their hometowns and the A&M campus from the air, and triggered cameras in the photo reconnaissance versions of the F-4 for aerial shots. The cadets were selected by AF-ROTC class ranking.

Flights are part of regular training for pilots of the 67th Tactical Reconnaissance Wing. Cadets were in

the back seat, where the navigator of the two-man crew normally operates. Pilots, including Capt. Tom Hughes and Tim Peppe last Monday, are from the 12th and 91st Tactical Recon Squadrons of the 67th.

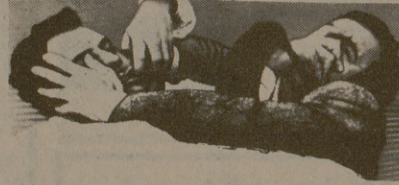
Part of the flights were low level runs, 200 to 300 feet above the ground at eight miles an hour east of Lufkin. The jets flew the A&M campus at 5:00 Monday on the return to Bergstrom.
